Bartlett Cove Mooring Agreement 2020

I certify that I am responsible for the placement, use, and removal of this Bartlett Cove mooring. I will adhere to all National Park Service, State, and Federal laws pertaining to the establishment of a mooring. Failure to do so may result in a violation notice and or loss of future privileges to place mooring buoys in Bartlett Cove. The mooring buoy must be white with a blue band and may show a white reflector or a light in accordance with the uniform state waterway marking system. The buoy must also have the vessel owner's name, city, and state of residence clearly displayed.

I understand that between June 1st and August 31st I must have a permit to exit Bartlett Cove (West of the fuel dock) or I may exit by removing my boat via the launch ramp.

36 CFR 13.1184 Rules for the safe and equitable use of Bartlett Cove waters and docks.

The placement of temporary moorings is authorized to the north or east of the Public Use Dock, provided they are **at least 300 yards OR 900 feet/274 Meters** from the dock (see attached map). These moorings must meet applicable marking requirements, may not be installed prior to April 1, and must be removed by November 1 in a given calendar year. Contact must be made with the District Ranger prior to placement of a mooring. Please return this form to the Visitor Information Station. *These limitations are necessary to ensure that fixed moorings not preempt the most convenient anchorage locations or impede access to the dock, are properly tended, and are temporary rather than permanent fixtures.*

Anchoring or mooring vessels within 100 yards of the Public Use Dock is prohibited



Temporary moorings authorized to the north or east of the Public Use Dock, provided they are at least 300 yards from the dock. These moorings must meet applicable marking requirements, may not be installed prior to April 1, and must be removed by November 1 in a given calendar year. Contact must be made with the Protection Ranger prior to placement of a mooring and Mooring Buoy Agreement signed.



Anchoring limited to 7 consecutive days and no buoys or lines may be placed unless otherwise authorized by a park ranger
