Road Construction Beginning on Utah Highway 276 near Halls Crossing *Motorists Advised to Expect Short Delays*

Page, AZ – Road construction on Utah Highway 276 in Glen Canyon National Recreation Area is beginning and will result in occasional short delays for drivers starting July 6. This road provides access to the Halls Crossing area, which includes a marina on Lake Powell, launch ramp, and campground.

The road is being repaved from the Glen Canyon National Recreation Area boundary near the Cal Black Memorial Airport to the road's end at the Halls Crossing ferry ramp. Culverts along the road are also being repaired and replaced.

While the National Park Service is working to insure that disruptions to park visitors are minimized, travelers to Halls Crossing should expect delays of up to 30- minutes at times. Visitors wishing to use the Lake Powell Ferry between Halls Crossing and Bullfrog should plan on allowing extra time before the ferry's departure due to the construction. Drivers are asked to use caution in the construction zone and to observe posted speed limits.

The \$5 million construction project is being completed in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration through the Federal Lands Highway Program. LeGrand Johnson Construction Company, of Logan, Utah, will be performing the road work through a contract.

The project is expected to be completed by November of this year.

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
