“We thank Mike and all of the other individuals who submitted photos for this contest,” said Acting Superintendent Stan Austin. “The dramatic red rock landscapes of Glen Canyon and Lake Powell are a perfect place for photographers.”

Second and third place winners include:

A panel of National Park Service employees and local community leaders met in January to select the winning photo. The winners of the contest all receive a free Glen Canyon annual entrance pass. The pass provides free admission to Glen Canyon National Recreation and normally costs \$30.
