

Directions to the Marin Headlands Visitor Center

(Building 948, Fort Barry, Sausalito, 94965)

From San Francisco:

1. Drive north across the Golden Gate Bridge. Exit at Alexander Avenue (just beyond the Vista Point).
2. Drive 0.2 miles on Alexander Avenue. Turn left onto Bunker Road (marked by a brown sign: Marin Headlands – Tunnel Route).
3. Drive to the 1-way Baker-Barry Tunnel, which is controlled by a 5-minute light. When the light is green, proceed through the tunnel.
4. Stay on Bunker Road for approximately 2.5 miles, until you see Field Road to your left.
5. Turn up Field Road, towards the Visitor Center.
6. The Visitor Center is in an old military chapel on your left.

From the East Bay/North Bay:

1. Travel south on Highway 101.
2. Take the second Sausalito exit (it's just before the Golden Gate Bridge). Bear right, and go back under the freeway. After 0.2 miles, turn left at Bunker Road (brown sign, Marin Headlands – Tunnel Route).
3. Follow directions from #3 above.

Note:

There are 2 routes into the Marin Headlands. If the tunnel is **closed** due to a power outage, return to Alexander Avenue (Marin Headlands – Coastal Route). Turn right as if you are going back to the Golden Gate Bridge. Just before the bridge on-ramp, you will see a steep road to your right, with a Marin Headlands sign. Proceed up the road. Turn right onto McCullough, left onto Bunker, and follow the signs to the Visitor Center on Field Road.
