


VESTIGES of *Lands End*

Merrie Way Concession Stands

The Merrie Way Concession Stands were housed in reused Mudjar-roofed buildings salvaged from the Midwinter's Fair. They offered fresh roasted peanuts, fruits, candy, drinks, and other refreshments to visitors. Nine small concessions lined the north side of Cliff Avenue (now Point Lobos Ave.) near the midway. These included a produce and refreshment stand (Stand O), an Oyster and Chop House (Stand S), and a cigar shop (Stand U). The stands provided a casual alternative to the formal dining of the Cliff House.

On nearby Ocean Beach and possibly at other locations, snacks (even ice cream!) and drinks were served from horse-drawn vending carts.
