

VESTIGES of *Lands End*

Stables

Among the many support buildings that helped maintain Adolph Sutro's extensive holdings were the stables. Located downhill from the main grounds of Sutro Heights, near the private lower gate entrance on Point Lobos Avenue, the stables probably housed dray horses that worked the grounds of Sutro Heights.

Nearby was a boarding house for gardeners and other Sutro employees who worked on the estate.

The stables were removed in the 1930s to create what is now the small parking area across Point Lobos Avenue from Louis' Restaurant.
