

Construct Restroom and Maintenance Facilities, and Other Site Improvements at Fort Funston

The National Park Service (NPS) is planning to construct a new restroom facility at Fort Funston. A 540 ft² building would be constructed to provide flush toilets near the northeast corner of the parking lot. The chemical toilets located at the northwest end of the main parking lot would be removed. The new restroom building will be ADA accessible and an accessible path will be created to connect to the parking lot and the Sunset Trail.

The new facility would be constructed using a prefabricated unit designed to be compatible with the landscape. The facility will have a low flush toilet and waterless urinal for men; two low-flush toilets for women; and a separate unisex accessible restroom. Bathrooms will have sinks, hand dryers, and baby changing stations.

The park is examining two alternatives for waste treatment. The restroom would connect to either the City of San Francisco sewer system or to the existing onsite septic system. If the existing system was utilized, another leachfield would be installed to accommodate the increased use.

GNRA began planning for the new restroom in 2003. Public scoping was conducted that year but the project was subsequently put on hold. This project is now being re-initiated and construction is proposed to begin in late 2009. An environmental assessment (EA) will be prepared for the project.

Public comments on the scope of the EA were accepted from November 18, 2008 to January 18, 2009.
