

## GMP Boundaries Subcommittee

### GMP Issue Statement:

#### Land and Water Protection

The plan will provide a vision for future land protection and boundary changes.

*Issue Description:*

Regional growth pressures and urbanization has influenced land acquisition and resulted in diverse types of park lands. The increase in acreage has presented challenges for land and boundary management. The parks could strengthen their strategic approach to land and resource protection by identifying guidelines and priorities for land acquisition, including a coordinated regional approach to land and resource management.

#### Subcommittee Goals:

- 1) Develop visions and goals (guidelines) that respond to the management concepts to guide land acquisition efforts and boundary adjustments for each of the alternatives.
- 2) Identify land areas or specific parcels that are needed to meet the visions and goals.

#### Phase I: Thursday, Aug. 2, 9:00 am – 4:30 pm

**Meeting Objectives:** To develop visions and goals that would guide land acquisition efforts for each of the alternatives; identify land areas or specific parcels that are needed to meet the relevant vision and goals.

**Activity 1:** Review the management concepts and their implications to land protection/acquisition. Develop a vision and supporting goals (guidelines) that would dictate what land could/would be acquired under each of the alternatives.

**Activity 2:** Review the GMP desired conditions of geographical areas (Marin, San Fran, San Mateo). Review maps of protected lands. Determine what, if any, land areas or specific parcels are needed to meet the visions and goals developed in Activity 1 (gap analysis). [Review the alternatives table as needed.]

**Tools:** Large-scale maps with zone boundaries; trace paper; markers; alternatives table; management zones table; GMP Issues; GOGA Land Protection Plan; ABAG GreenVision study maps; BAOSC Upland Goals study maps; laptop and projector.

**Meeting Objective:** Test and finalize previous work. Make arrangements for discussion with BAOSC or other land protection organizations.
