LANDS END PHASE II ENHANCEMENTS BEGIN AUGUST 2010

The Golden Gate National Parks Conservancy, in partnership with the National Park Service, will continue site improvements at Lands End, thanks to a generous lead gift from the Richard and Rhoda Goldman Fund, with support from the Horace W. Goldsmith Foundation and Conservancy members. This includes upgrades to the *USS San Francisco* Memorial parking area and overlook, construction of a new visitor facility, and continued habitat restoration and cultural resource restoration. Phase II begins with the construction of the new parking area in August.

The Memorial parking area will be closed August through December 2010.

PHASE II PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- Rehabilitate USS San Francisco Memorial parking area (August 2010 December 2010)
- Design and construct visitor facility in the lower Lands End parking lot (June 2010 October 2011)
- Continue natural and cultural resource stewardship, including forest management activities (ongoing)
- Restore native habitat and construct an overlook at Eagle's Point (TBD)
