Narrative:

on 04/22/2013 at approximately 1840 hours, I was driving into the parking lot of Fort Funston toward the Ranger station, when I saw a woman holding a leashed dog flagging me down near one of the patrol cars. At the very same time, communications put out over the radio that that they needed a unit to respond to the Fort Funston area for the report of a subject down and bleeding. As I got closer to the station, I saw a woman with her back to the front tire of the Park Ranger sedan with a very bloody right leg. I advised communications that I had a downed female and to roll an ambulance.

I exited my patrol car and asked what occurred. I immediately recognized the down female to be that of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) is the elderly woman who rides her bike to the Funston area and complains about all the off leash dogs. I gathered my medical bag and asked (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) what happened. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stayed on the ground and stated she was bitten by the dog that was being held by its owner later identified as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). I gloved up and told (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) that I wanted to check out her leg. As I knelt down and began to render care to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) she told me that she did not want any medical attention. I looked at her and asked again could I render aid. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that she did not want care, she did not want her wounds covered up and she wanted them exposed. All she wanted was the case number for the incident and stated that the government was responsible since it allowed all the dogs off leash and the incident happened on government property. I informed communications to cancel the ambulance and asked (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) again, what happened.

(b) (6), (b) (7) later told me she was on her way home riding her bike through the parking lot. She was then bitten on the leg by the dog. I asked if she had fallen after the bite. She replied, "No!" She went on to say that she was fine and only wanted her case number. I later turned to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and asked what happened.

According to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) she and her Australian Shepard (b) (6), (b) (7) were in the parking lot near her car. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated she was wiping (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) off when he noticed (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) riding by on her bike. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) broke away and gave chase of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) peddled faster as to evade (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) called out to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) but it was too late. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) eventually bit her on the right lower calf/shin region. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) called 911. I arrived in the lot approximately 2 minutes later.

I had both parties fill out statements detailing what occurred. Once I obtained the case number, I gave it to (b) (6), (b) (7) along with information about the viscous dog unit with San Francisco Police Department. She then got on her bike and pedaled home. Before she left, I reiterated the importance of getting her wounds checked out. I obtained photos of the injuries and filled out an animal bite report. I faxed the report to Animal Care and Control (415-8642866) and all units cleared at 2017 hours

On 4/19/13 around 1545 hours I was contacted by (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) He reported that he had been bitten by a dog at about 1520 hours. He showed me 2 small puncture wounds on the inside of his left forearm.

LAW ENFORCEMENT SENSITIVE (FOUO)

He said that the dog was a tan short-hair dog about 50 lbs. He wasn't sure of the breed. The dog was accompanied by an Asian man and woman in their late 20's or early 30's. He said the man was about 5' 9" and slender with crew cut type hair. He had no description for the female.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said he had been walking on the coastal trail when the dog ran at him, bit his left forearm and hung on. He said the man yelled, "NO!" and the dog let go. The Asian couple then quickly moved away without contacting him. He did not realized he was injured until a moment later, at which point he came to find me.

We searched the parking area and trail area without finding the suspects. I applied anti-biotic gel to the wound and suggested he seek medical attention. I faxed the San Francisco Dog Bite Report to Animal Control and posted flyers around the Ft. Funston parking area looking for information about the suspect. I have no leads or evidence currently.



On 2/27/13 at about 1430 hours, Park employee Mike Coffey was bitten by a dog named "stella" that was being walked by a Professional Dog Walker, named (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) is a 20 - 30 pound, 8 month old, shepard mix, that is black and tan in color.

Coffey was picking brush off the ground, when (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) barked, charged, and bit Coffey on the left hand. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was off leash. Once (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) bit Coffey, he yelled to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to leash her dog while he fended off with his foot. She was able to regain control of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and leashed the dog.

Coffey came to find me at the Ranger station and asked (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to wait for him to return. When I examined the wound I found a lac/abrasion about 1/4" x 1/4" that was not actively bleeding, though the skin was broken to the degree that disease transmission was a concern. Coffey took me to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) who was waiting by the Maintenance Facility. Her story of what had happened matched the description above.

I told (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) that I would normally write a citation for "creating a hazardous condition" in addition to filing a dog bite report with the county. Coffey asked that I not write a citation, since he had gotten the impression that the Park Management would rather not do that. I told him I would give him 2 days to think about it, then contact him again.

I contacted SF County Animal Control and faxed the dog bite report to Lt. Brown. I will follow up to insure that the report was received.

On February 25th, 2013 at approximately 1420 hours, Park Communications received a phone call from a man who wished to report an incident involving his dog getting bit by another person's dog at Fort Funston.

I responded from 19th Avenue at Santiago and arrived on scene at 1430 hours. I contacted the reporting party who I identified as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) of San Francisco, CA.

He explained to me that his dog was running off leash in an open area north of the main parking when another dog was hunched down in the ice plant waiting for his dog to run by. As his dog did ran by, the waiting dog pounced and subsequently bit his dog (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) reported the skin was torn and his dog had bleed.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) also advised he attempted to contact the owner of the dog who bit his and as he did so, that owner became agitated and belligerent with him. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told me he wanted to exchange information because his dog would need several stitches due to the injuries it suffered. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) reported the male subject to be in his 50's, wearing a blue jacket, gray cargo pants, and sunglasses. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was also able to capture this subject's license plate which is (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)

This vehicle registration returns to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) of San Francisco, CA (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) reported to me that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told him to "Fuck off" at one point during their interaction. There was a female companion with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) who provided (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) with the name of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and a phone number of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)

INVESTIGATION:

On February 24th 2013 at approximately 1315 hours, I received a report of an attack on a dog with a knife by a Asian Male at Fort Funston. I met with San Francisco Police Officers (SFPD) at the John Muir Gate. After searching the area SFPD located the location of the incident and advised that the wounded animal and its owners were on scene. After I arrived all involved parties were located. Based on the statements giving by the two parties, I determined that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) had their two Pit Bull Dogs off leash on the trail. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) were walking on the trail with their two dogs trailing behind them, also off leash when (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) dog was approached by the two of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) dogs. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that one of the dogs stopped when (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) dog returned to him but the other attached (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) dog. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that he tried to break up the dogs by hitting (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) dog with his plastic leash, which had no effect. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that while he was trying to break up the fight between the two dogs he "became scared for my own safety", at which point he pulled his pocket knife out and stabbed the attacking dog. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that after (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) dog released his dog, he tried to offer assistance but (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) threatened him. On 02/17/2013 at approximately 1645 hours, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) came to the Fort Funston Ranger station to report a dog attack involving her dog and the dog of another dog walker. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was a little agitated because she noticed (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was injured with a puncture wound to the right inner thigh area. She stated to me that she called the other dog owner, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), and asked her how to proceed regarding payment of the vet bill. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) that she wasn't paying for anything and that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) attacked her dog (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). I had (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) fill out a complainant statement. While filling out the statement, I called (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and requested her to come to the ranger station to fill out a statement as well.

According to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), she arrived at Fort Funston at 1550 hours with her 5 year old American Eskimo (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) for a dog walk. Her dog (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was on leash. She then took (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) off leash to use the restroom. After using the restroom, she noticed that Mia had feces on herself and decided to walk back to the car to get some wipes. She leashed (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and noticed another group of four subjects with several dogs off leash heading in her direction so she took a wide walk with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) as to avoid any contact with the dogs. While passing the group, one of the dogs, a black and brown Shepard (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) came up to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and sniffed. The dogs began fighting. An attacked ensued ending with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) on top of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). The boyfriend of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) finally got the dogs separated. They set up two rope systems for a lower and raise and they successfully rescued the trapped dog. I issued K113486 for 36 CFR 2.34(a)(4), Creating a hazardous condition (\$275). She was released on-scene and all units cleared at approx. 1400 hrs.

Narrative: On January 27, 2013, at approximately 1314 hrs. I received a call from USPP Communications about a pit bull dog that had bitten a equestrian down on Fort Funston beach. The reporting party, later identified as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was on a horse when the incident happened. She said the brown pit bull was with a black male owner who was wearing a black t-shirt and tan backpack. I responded to the area and checked the Fort Funston beach area on foot. The beach was experiencing high visitation. I inquired with several visitors concerning a horse and pit bull encounter. No one had seen a horse or pit bull on the beach within the last 20-30 minutes. USPP Communications said that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) had returned to the Mar Vista Stables with her horse. I walked back up to my vehicle and met with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) at the Stables. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said she was riding her horse on Ocean Beach near the southern border of Fort Funston when a pit bull ran toward her group of horses. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said the pit bull was with a black male, 30's, wearing a black beanie, black t-shirt, dark jeans, and carrying a tan backpack. The black male was traveling with a white female, 30, with long blonde hair. They had a second tan chow dog with them. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said she turned her horse toward the brown pit bull and it ran up and bit the right front leg. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said they were heading north while the dog owner was proceeding south. After the dog bit the horse, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said the man yelled at her to stop riding her horse toward his dog. According to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) the female yelled, "my dog has never seen a horses before and I want to see what he does." The pit bull ran toward the female and she finally put him on a leash. dog had become stranded on a cliff at Fort Funston. I called for assistance from NPS units and from San Francisco Fire.

The woman on the north end of the cliff, was the tenant of the dogs owner. The tenant on the cliff was (b) (6), (b) (7)(C).
