E-Bikes Permitted


E-Bicycles are allowed on all paved roads or sidewalks unless posted.

The speed limit for e-bicycles in undeveloped areas is 15 mph and 5 mph in areas of limited visibility, steep terrain, and when approaching other trail users.

The park receives millions of visitors per year. These restrictions are intended to reduce conflict between users and to address public safety concerns and protection for natural and cultural resources that are highly sensitive to human-induced impacts.

All trails or paths not specifically identified here as open to E-bikes are closed to them.

Bicycles are allowed on all paved roads or sidewalks unless posted.


The speed limit for the bicycles in undeveloped areas is 15 mph and 5 mph in areas of limited visibility, steep terrain, and when approaching other trail users.

BICYCLE GROUPS: maximum number of bicyclists in any one group is 10. Larger groups of cyclists will have to divide into groups of no larger than 10.
