Item 1. Proposed Zoning Changes

Objective: To review and decide about proposed zoning changes for Muir Woods NM Alternative 3.

Background: Camino del Canyon: At the last meeting the cultural resource office recommended changes in zoning to preserve Hillwoods school, druids, and Watts library. In addition, there is a proposal at Muir Woods NM to replace sensitive zone on the northeast side to Interpretive Corridor . Should Fitzgerald Marine Reserve be zoned sensitive?

Item 2. Format for Presenting the Alternatives in the GMP

Objective: To decide on the format for how the alternatives will be displayed in the GMP.

Background: The DSC team has been approached by various park managers with recommendations regarding how the alternatives should be displayed in the GMP. An opportunity to discuss and then decide on the format is needed now in order to appropriately direct the editors.

Item 3. Staffing Levels of Draft Alternatives

Objective: To refine the approach to identifying staffing levels, FTEs and associated costs for each alternative.

Background: There has been a need for some additional guidance in how to determine staffing levels for each alternative. First, in order to compare alternatives and to meet NPS standards the GMP needs to: 1) identify total number of FTEs; 2) identify the costs of labor; 3) address why the staffing levels are changed (what are the positions going toward). What's happening in the alternative that would influence staffing needs. Ned to document our rationale.

Item 4. Alternatives for Boundaries

Objective: To agree on the approach and concept for addressing future boundary changes for each alternative.

Background: Over the last two years the planning team has developed an approach for how boundary changes and acquisitions would be addressed for each alternative. Now is the time to review and refine the boundary alternatives to reflect the recent decisions. Is there just one alternative common to all or one for each alternative?

Note: Carrying Capacity work needs to be submitted to Kerri by April 3, 2009. Kerri will prepare a draft for steering committee review scheduled for April 23, 2009.
