The U.S Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) announces the availability for public review of files comprising the Administrative Record for the selection of the remedial response action at the Fort Barry Firing Range Complex, Marin County, CA. The USACE seeks to inform the public of the availability of the Administrative Record and to encourage the public to comment on documents as they are placed into the Administrative Record.

The Administrative Record includes documents which form the basis for the selection of a remedial response action at this Formerly Used Defense Site (FUDS) project. Documents currently in the Administrative Record include determination of eligibility/Preliminary Assessment reports, Site Investigation reports, and validated sampling data. Other documents will be added to the Administrative Record files as the FUDS project work progresses. These additional documents may include, but are not limited to, the Public Involvement Plan, Remedial Investigation/Feasibility report, Treatability Study reports, Proposed Plan, Decision Document, other technical reports, additional validated sampling data, data submitted by interested persons, and USACE responses to significant comments.

The Administrative Record is available for review during normal business hours (9:30 AM to 4:30 PM, daily) at the Marin Headlands Visitor's Center, 948 Fort Barry, Sausalito, CA. Additionally it can be viewed from 9 AM to 4 PM Monday through Friday at the USACE Sacramento District, 1325 "J" Street Sacramento, CA.
