GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE 75th Anniversary <u>Visitor</u> Improvements




The Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District is partnering with the Golden Gate National Parks Conservancy and National Park Service to improve the visitor experience and visitor facilities on the southeast side of the Golden Gate Bridge, in preparation for the Bridge's 75th anniversary in May 2012.

PROPOSED PROJECT:

- Construct the 75th Anniversary Pavilion, a new, interim 3,500 square foot facility offering interpretive exhibits and visitor services, including retail currently housed in the Round House.
- Renovate the Round House interior for educational programs, staging for visitor programs, special events, and take-out coffee.
- Expand the visitor plaza for gathering and orientation. Trim and remove trees to restore historic views from the plaza.
- Reconfigure the visitor parking lot to improve circulation and pedestrian safety
- Improve accessibility, signage, interpretation and visitor information
- Upgrade the existing Bridge Café.
