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Narrative: On Sunday, January 13, 2013 at approximately 1115 hours, I took a walk-in report at building 1217 (USPP sub-station) regarding a dog attack that took place on January 3rd, 2013 at Crissy Field.

The reporting party stated:



"January 3rd 2013 12:30pm Crissy Field

A leashed dog I was walking was attacked and bitten by an unleashed dog. The owner refuses to take responsibility. Her name is (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)

As we were walking to the beach, a dog approached us. It was an Akita. It was not on a leash. As the dog walked up to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (my client's dog) he snapped and bit (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) on the head and below his eye. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was 20 feet away leashing up her dogs. She admitted she did not see what happened. Then once I called her over to see the injured dog, she offered to pay half of the medical bill. I refused the offer. Her dog was off leash and not under her control. She refused to give me her address.

The injured dogs owner is (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)

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

Narrative: On 09/11/2013 at approximately 1900 hours I responded to the south side of Baker Beach for a report of a dog bite. The original reporting party, identified as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) reported that he had been bite by a tan colored pit pull while on the beach. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) reported that the two hispanic females were still in the area and had two tan colored pit bulls with them. I responded to the south side of Baker Beach in order to locate the dogs and suspects in question. As I walked out onto the beach I observed a white male, later identified as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and a hispanic female, later identified verbally as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) along the water's edge with two tan colored dogs. I observed the one dog to be a pit bull and the other was a boxer mix. I observed (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) running around in circles, away from the dogs who were running around him. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) began chasing after the dogs and eventually got ahold of the boxer mix's color and she began walking away (headed further south).

As I approached the (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) he began yelling "That dog bit me, he just bit me!" I began shouting for (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to stop as she was in close proximity to me, however she failed to comply. I continually shouted for (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to stop by stating, "Police Stop, Ma'am with the tan dog stop!" (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) did not comply. I was able to gain footage and as I got closer I again ordered (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to stop or she would be arrested, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) then turned around and made contact with me. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) began to turn to walk away and I again had to order her to stop. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was agitated and initially did not listen to any commands. Once (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) calmed down she explained that she did not know I was a police officer and that she was going to get the dog's lease. A second female, later identified through (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) license as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) appeared with a leash for the second dog, a tan 1 year old pit by the name of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)

I instructed (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to get the secondary leash for the 4 year old male boxer mix, by the name of

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) complied.

During my investigation it was learned that there were two male victims, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) reported being attacked walking north on the south end of Baker Beach. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that at approximately 1900 hours the tan dog started circling and jumping and began nipping at his right calf, right arm and right side of his buttocks, breaking skin. (see photos). (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that he called to the owner to call the dog and leash him. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that the female came over but did not respond but eventually put the dog on a leash, stating that the dog was just playing. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) later identified (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) as the dog that bite him.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that at approximately 1910 hours he was jogging on Baker Beach, as he was jogging a brown dog (boxer mix) began running towards him rapidly. (V2) stated that the dog was approximately 100 meters away when he initially saw him running towards him. (V2) stated that he immediately stopped and the dog came close to him and began running around him in circles, biting him on the left arm and left upper thigh. I observed injuries to both areas. (see photos).


As I walked the group up to the parking lot for further investigation, Officer Hall advised me that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) owner was on scene with his rabies information that I had requested. I then made contact with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) who claimed to be the rightful owner of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) handed me a current rabies tag with number (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) Balboa Pet Hospital (415-752-3300). (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was suppose to be walking (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) for her.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that she did not know (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) had aggression issues and had never seen this behavior before. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that she knew (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) did not like men but had never bit anyone before and that she always keeps him leashed.

Animal Care and Control Officer Sandler was notified and instructed me to advise (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to quarantine (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) for 10 days and any further action will be taken up with Animal Care and Control. This information was passed on to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) who was completely cooperative and remorseful. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) took possession of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and left the area without further incident.

I then issued (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) a citation for 36 CFR 2.15(a)(2)-Unleashed Pet.

Narrative: On 09/16/2013 at approximately 1630 hours I took a delayed report from an (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). Her statement via email is as follows: "On Sunday, September 1, 2013 at Fort Funston and around 4:20pm. My husband and children were at the cliff side watching schools of dolphins go by and (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and I were walking slow toward the parking lot to our car, we had spent approximately 2 1/2 hours walking to the beach, and playing in the ocean. What happened next unfolded pretty quickly. I noticed a large (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) walking kind of fast toward us. In a moment everything changed, the (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) moved in toward the back of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and he went to mount I told (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to turn, he did the (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) thought that was a reason to attack and he did. As (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) moved to get away the (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) grew more and more aggressive and continued to bite (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). I noticed a group of people surrounding me, but no one would help me. I placed myself between the two dog trying to grab a collar of the Akita (there was no collar)

help me. I placed myself between the two dog trying to grab a collar of the Akita (there was no collar) and I kept calling the other dog owner to come and retrieve his dog from attacking my dog-he did nothing. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) cried out and continued to try and move, as the (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) continued to attack. I could not stop the attack no matter what I did. Finally (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) cried out pretty loud and stopped in his tracks, showed his teeth and growled like I have never heard him before. Finally the (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) backed off. There was blood everywhere and (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was the one hurt and when he came to me I placed his lead on him and he looked at me like he was going to die! I love my dog like I love my children-he should not have lived through that attack. The other owner disappears with his Akita walking off like nothing happened. At this point I am upset and I scream at him he turns on the walk and he comes back. An innocent bystander was walking over to get the other owner, which I was not aware of. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was bleeding from a puncture in his lower right leg near his foot, his body was tense and he was in A LOT of pain. I tried to assess him the best I could while I cleaned him up. The other owner approached and I had to ask him to put his dog on his lead-there again he approaches with his dog that has not been submitted, stayed and or even reprimanded for what he did. I looked up at the man and I said to him you don't remember do you and he said what? I said you do not remember this is (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said oh no, I am so sorry-I said then why did you walk away? The other owners name is (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) he is a resident of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and his dog is the Akita names (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) male, six years old, 120lbs. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) claimed that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) had all his shots and that they are current. He also stated that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) never did this before and I look at him and said (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) that is not a true statement.
