I issued (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) a citation for 36 CFR 2.15(a)(2): failure to leash dog in an area requiring dogs be leashed.

Observation:

On January 1, 2014 at approximately 1700 hours, Ranger Robert Lewis and I were flagged down by a Hispanic male I identified as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that his son had been bitten by a dog and that the dog owner drove away. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) along with his wife (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and friend (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) were all witnesses to the dog bite. I identified the victim of the dog bite as Juvenile1, a seven year old boy.

Witness Statements:

There were several witnesses to the dog bite. The witnesses I took statements from are (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)

All witnesses stated the following: Juvenile1 was playing near the water at Rodeo Beach and throwing rocks in the water. A big dog came out of the water near Juvenile1 and chased him. Juvenile1 ran from the dog and the dog bit him in the butt leaving three puncture wounds. The Dog was described as a big golden dog with a black mouth.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) added to her statement that after the dog had bitten Juvenile1 it turned and started chasing her around the beach. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) fell down to the ground and the dog ran over her.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) added stated the following: That the owner of the dog later identified as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said her dog did not bite there son. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told the (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) that her dog was not aggressive and she left the scene even though (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) were trying to attend to their son.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) added to his statement that he followed (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) back to her vehicle as she was leaving the scene and took photographs of her and her dog as well as her vehicle she drove away in which was a red Toyota with CA plate

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)

After I finished interviewing all of the witness to the dog bite I called (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that she was at the movie theatre and would be busy for the next three hours. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that I could call her back at around 2030 hours.

I called (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) back and interviewed her over the phone. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told me that a chubby boy was playing near the water throwing rocks into the water. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said that when the boy saw her dog he looked scared and ran away from it. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said the only way to stop her dog from chasing (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was to hug him. Juvenile1's mother was very upset. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) that your dog bit my

son. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that she did not see any tares in the boy's pants. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) wanted to see medical proof that her dog had bitten the boy. I told (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) I documented three puncture wounds on Juvenile1's butt. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) wanted proof that the wounds matched her dog's teeth. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) had pulled her son's pants down on the beach and pinched Juvenile1's butt which inflicted the wounds on his butt.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told me that her dog was a gold in color (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) with a black nose. The dog's name is (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) is a service dog for emotional support. The dog has been through doggy boot camp.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) also told me that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) asked her for \$1000.00 USD because the dog bit the boy. During my interview with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and the other witnesses they all denied ever asking for any money. There was a big language barrier between (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) speaks English while the others are only fluent in Spanish.

I told (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) I was mailing her two citations in the mail. One for failure to keep your dog on a leash or under voice control and the other was for creating a hazardous condition, the dog bite. I also told (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) I was filing a dog bite report through the Marin Humane Society and that they would be contacting her.

Follow Up:

On January 2, 2014 I contacted the Marin Humane Society to file the dog bite report. The Humane Society stated that they had already been contacted by the Marin General hospital about the incident. I gave the Humane Society (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) information so they could finish the report. I also requested the medical report from the dog bite.

On 1/10/14 at approximately 1530 hours I received a report from Park Dispatch regarding a cold aggressive dog incident at Mori Point. I called the reporting party and spoke with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), who reported an interaction with a confrontational man who was walking his dogs offleash in the area of the northern boundary of the park near the seawall.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) reported that at approximately 1430 hours, he was walking his leashed dogs toward the Bootlegger Steps, when a man walking two brown wired haired terriers was walking toward (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that the terriers were not on leash and charged (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) dog. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that he yelled for the man to control his dogs, at which point the man became verbally abusive to him. The terriers then attacked (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) leashed dog for approximately 1.5-2 minutes, causing punctures wounds. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated he continued hiking with his dog toward the top of Mori Point following the altercation.

On 09/12/2014 around 16:20 hours I was dispatched to Tennessee Valley for a complaint of a reddish-brown, medium sized dog defecating on Tennessee Valley Beach. I responded within 30 minutes (reasonable drive time from 507 McRenolds Rd in Fort Baker with traffic).

As I approached the beach around 16:50 hours in a fully marked law enforcement Chevy Silverado, I was flagged down approximately one quarter of a mile from the beach along the main trail. The complainant (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was a (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) pushing a black running stroller with a boy looking to be about four or five years old. I asked if the dog she had called about was still on the beach, she said no, and explained how she had called Golden Gate Dispatch one and a half hours prior to my arrival. I stated I came over as soon as I got the call from my Dispatcher. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said she enjoys coming to Tennessee Valley beach because it is a dog free beach, therefore her four year old son can run in the sand without worrying about stepping in dog feces. She claimed she comes to the beach about twice a month and every time there are dogs, and every time she calls our dispatch to get a law enforcement unit out to fix the problem.

She continued to inform me the dog the initial complaint was made about had eaten seaweed and immediately started getting sick all over the beach. She said she had approached the owner of the dog to educate him on the dog policies of Tennessee Valley trails and beach, and he claimed not to care. She informed him he could get a fine if the Rangers showed up, and he still told her he still did not care. She then started asking me why we (the Rangers) were not ticketing for dogs in Tennessee Valley. I articulated to her we are very short staffed and could not be everywhere we want to be. I informed her since we are short staffed and have to cover a large area we are not able to make it to Tennessee Valley as much as we would like. I apologized for any inconvenience and stated I would inform my supervisor and I would make an increased effort to patrol Tennessee Valley more often. She said she would write to the park about the problem and walked off.

After checking the beach and seeing no violations I cleared the beach and started driving back towards the parking lot at Tennessee Valley trail head. As I drove up the hill where Tennessee Valley Trail meets with the Coastal Trail I noticed a couple (one male and one female) with a brown medium-sized dog on a leash walking towards the beach on the Tennessee Valley Cut-off trail. I turned around and intercepted them at around 17:30 hours at the intersection of Tennessee Valley trail and the Tennessee Valley Cut-off trail.

As I approached them I noticed the dog had a red vest on with a white circle in the middle. I asked the couple if the dog was service dog, the said yes. They offered to show me the dogs paperwork. I said I don't need to see those I just need to know what service it provides, they said it detects seizures I thanked them for their time. They then

stated a lady matching (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) description who was pushing a stroller walking towards the parking lot had asked similar questions. This woman attempted to tell the couple they were not allowed to bring their dog to the beach, and it wasn't really a service dog. She asked the couple for paperwork to prove the dog was in fact a service dog. I thanked them for their time and told them to have a good day.

Around 18:00 I was asked by dispatch to call (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) I immediately pulled over as soon as I got reception and called (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). When she answered I informed her who I was and we had spoken earlier in the day. She began telling me the dog she had initially called about (matching the couple with the service dog's description) was heading back to the beach when she was walking out. I informed her the dog in question was a service dog and could in fact be on the beach according to ADA regulations. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said the dog was not a service dog, which the papers and vest were bought online and they are not allowed to be down there. I educated her on what I could do and ask as a public official with regards to asking about service dogs, and on the difference between service dogs and comfort dogs and what we recognize and allow into our no dog areas. On 10/8/14 at about 1245 hours I was contacted by a jogger on Ocean Beach. He reported that he had been bitten by a dog. He held up his arm to show me slobber marks and 2 tooth marks on his sweatshirt sleeve. He identified himself as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and told me that he had been running near a group of dogs, which were off-leash. He said one of the dogs ran to him and jumped up and bit him on the left forearm. (see photo) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that the dogs were being walked by a white woman and he gestured to a woman walking a pack of dogs at the north end of the beach. She was the only person at that end of the beach with more than 1 dog. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said that the dog had bitten him while the woman had her back turned. He said she was dealing with the other dogs at the time. I saw that there were a total of 7 dogs.

DOG DESCRIPTION

He described the dog as a grey, shorthaired, pit bull. He said the dog let go quickly and did not bite too hard as to break the skin. He said that since there were many other dogs in its pack, it did worry him. He was worried that the other dogs might also start attacking him.

CONTACT WITH THE DOG WALKER

I approached the woman that was walking the dogs. There were 7 dogs and all of them were off-leash. She was beginning to place the dogs on leashes, since there was a horse nearby, she said. The dogs appeared well behaved and appeared to follow her direction, though she had to call after at least 1 dog multiple times, before it came to her.

I explained that a person had been bitten by one of her dogs. I explained that it was a pit bull that had bit the person. She had only 1 pit bull that was not muzzled. It was grey with short hair.

COMMERCIAL DOG WALKER

I asked for her identifying information. She handed me a California issued ID card in the name (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). I asserted that she was walking dogs commercially, she did not deny my assertion. I also asked for her commercial dog walking permit. She said she had one, but did not have it on her. She didn't know the number nor the name under which her business would be listed. She thought it might be under (b) (6), (b) (7)(C).

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) had spoken briefly with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) so knew which dog had bitten him

and what he alleged. She did not deny his allegation. She explained that sometimes dogs reacted negatively to men in dark hooded sweatshirts because they were more threatening.

When I asked who the owner of the dog was, she said it was (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) of San Francisco. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) described the pit bull as 3 years old and named, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). She said it was a blue nose pitbull, which described its grey color.

She was polite and friendly during our contact

DISPOSITION

I told (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) that I was going to check her permit. I said I would also check the history of the dog to make sure there was no record of it having bitten anyone in San Mateo or San Francisco County. I said that as long as the dog had not bitten anyone before, I would take no action against the dog.

ACTIONS

I contacted Sherry Hicks of San Francisco Police's vicious dog unit to check on (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) status in San Francisco county. I have not yet contacted San Mateo County Animal control.

On 10-8-14 at about 12:45 hours I was contacted by Park Volunteer Horse Patrol Hedstrom while I was in the Tennessee Valley Parking lot. I was on horseback and in full uniform. She gestured to a man with a dog and said that he was rude and had attempted to take his dog to Tennessee Valley Beach.

OBSERVATIONS

When Hedstrom gestured to the man, I saw him bend down and put his small white dog on a leash that was held in his hand. Prior to this I saw that the dog was off leash. Hedstrom reported that the dog was also off leash.

CONTACT WITH SOTOMAYOR

When I contacted the man, he kept his body pointed away from me and continued to walk past me until I told him twice to stop. He spoke in a loud, fast, and higher tone than I heard later in our conversation. His face was held in a creased-brow demeanor.

When I told him the second time that he had to stop, he turned to face me. I told him that the volunteer had reported to me that she had warned him earlier that the trail was closed to dogs and that he had initially not complied with the closure. His dog was barking at my horse, so I asked the man to continue the contact in the parking lot near his car, so that he could put his dog in the car. We walked to his car and he put his dog inside.

VIDEO CAMERA

I asked for his identifying information, and he gave me his California ID card which identified him as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). As he approached, I saw that he was holding a small video camera in his left hand. It was a small camera that allowed him to hold it like a small can so that just the lense showed. His demeanor was different once he put the dog in the car and emerged with the camera in his hand. His voice was lower, not as loud, and the rate was slower.

I checked his identification for wants and warrants and there were none.

SERVICE ANIMAL

I explained again to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) that dogs were prohibited on the Tennessee Valley trail. He asked if service animals were exempt. It was the first time he had mentioned service animals to Hedstrom or I. I said service animals were

allowed but that they still needed to be on a leash. I asked if his animal was trained. He initially didn't know what I meant. I asked where his animal had been trained to be a service animal. He said he wasn't sure but it was some place in San Rafael. I asked what training the animal had received. He said it had been trained to be a companion animal. I explained that service animals were permitted but that they needed to be on a leash.

I introduced myself and after talking with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), I learned that he was a resident of the Outer Sunset just across the street from the beach. He had lived there for some time according to him. I explained to him that he was in a National Park and the regulation prohibited off leash pets in the area. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated the he wasn't sure when the closure began but had heard about it. I asked for and was granted his identification. I conducted a computer check for any wants. The computer check returned clear. I explained to him the dates of the closure, locations along the beach where the closure did not apply and made sure that he was aware of the parameters concerns his pet on Ocean beach. On 12/1/2014 at approximately 1330 hours, Ranger Goodwin and I were on Ocean beach 4x4 patrol when we noticed a female subject standing nearby her off leash dog as it chased the ravens sitting on the beach. The subject was near Noriega avenue approximately 50 feet west of the cross walk. This area is a wildlife protection closure and pets are to be on leash from stairwell 21 all the way south to Sloat boulevard. Noriega avenue is in the 3/4 the way between these two points. I pulled my patrol SUV over to the subject and exited my vehicle.

I greeted and introduced myself to the subject later identified as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). I told her that the area she was in, was a National Park and there were regulations pertaining to pets along the beach. She leashed the pet. I asked if she was aware the area was a National Park. She replied that she was not. Ranger Goodwin stood off in the distance behind me as I spoke to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). I told her what drew our attention to her was that she allowed the dog to chase the birds on two occasions without calling off the pet. I also told her that failing to leash the pet was the other concern. She stated that she was not aware of the rules. I then asked if she was from the neighborhood to which she replied, "I'm from another neighborhood!". I noticed all the while, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) maintained a larger than normal distance between she and I. While still holding the leash of her leashed dog, I asked her if she had any identification with her. She hesitated and then asked, "What, are you gonna write me ticket or something!" I told her that up until this time, I haven't mentioned any citations. She then grabbed her wallet and handed me her driver's license. While writing down her driver's license, I told her that I was identifying her so that I, or any other officer would already know that she had been contacted for the violation in the past. I asked if this address on the license was current. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) snapped back at me and stated "You can run it and it will come up!" I told her that I hadn't raised my voice, and that I had been very professional with her. I then advised communication to conduct a license and warrant check on the identification. I began filling out the citation.

Ranger Goodwin walked closer and spoke to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) while I completed the citation. I overheard (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) tell Ranger Goodwin, "If your gonna write me a ticket, can you hurry up, I have places to go!" I then heard Ranger Goodwin ask her if she had voice control with her pet. She replied, "Yes!" He then asked if that was the case, why did she not call the dog off when it was chasing the birds? (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) replied sarcastically, "They are crows!" He stated they are birds and dogs are not to chase birds. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that her dog chases pigeons all the time. He stated they are birds too and chasing them is prohibited as well.

Once the citation was completed, I walked over to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and told her that she was being cited. I also told her that her attitude was un-called for. I informed her that before speaking to her as I watched the dog chase the birds, I had was not

going to issue a citation. However, her behavior persuaded me otherwise. I informed her that she could contest the cite if she felt it was issued unjustly. I asked her to sign the citation. She refused. I wrote refused on the citation and gave her her copy.

Initial Information:

On December 15th, 2014, at approximately 13:20, while on foot patrol of the Alta Trail, within Golden Gate National Recreation Area, I observed a male subject, approximately 100 yards from my location, on a social trail west of the Alta Trail with what appeared to be more than six dogs. Within GGNRA, dog walkers with more than three dogs are required to buy a permit through the business office. The regulations state a dog walker may not have more than six dogs at one time. The male subject saw me approaching and turned around and began walking out of my view.

Actions taken:

Ranger Gibbs and I hiked up the social trail in an attempt to contact the dog walker. When Ranger Gibbs and I made it to the top of the trail, the dog walker was no longer in sight. I began to hike down the social trail, in the direction of Tennessee Valley Road, and Ranger Gibbs hiked back down towards Alta Trail in case the subject attempted to head towards his vehicle by way of other social trails. Upon hiking down the social trail towards Tennessee Valley Road, I did not observe the subject. I hiked back up towards the Alta Trail in order to attempt to find a better vantage point. I found another social trail and was able to observe the subject hiking back up towards the Alta Trail. I alerted Ranger Gibbs and we made contact with the subject south of the Alta Ave Trailhead signage. The subject had eight dogs in his possession and was not wearing his permit badge. Per the commercial use agreement, all commercial dog walkers are required to wear their permit badges in a visible location.

I identified the man as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (DOB: (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)) by his name and date of birth. I had issued (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) a citation on September 24th, 2014 for failure to obtain a commercial dog walking permit (CASE # NP14121813). As I was waiting for his information return from USPP Dispatch, two of his dogs began to become aggressive and bark at Ranger Gibbs and me. Both dogs would run up to Ranger Gibbs and me and jump up on our legs. We ordered (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to leash the dogs but he stated he did not have a leash for the dogs. Both dogs did not have collars or proper state licensure.

Ranger Gibbs asked (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) if he had a commercial dog walking permit he stated he had one but it was in his vehicle. Ranger Gibbs used his cellphone to contact Kathrine Beltrano, the NPS business office employee in charge of the commercial dog walking permits, to find out whether (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) a valid permit. Ranger Gibbs tried both of her phone numbers three separate times but Beltrano did not answer.

During the contact another dog walker with one dog under voice control attempted to walk his dog around (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and his group of eight dogs. Four of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) dogs began barking and aggressively charged the dog walker's dog. Ranger Gibbs ordered (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to call his dogs back. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) attempted to gain control of the dogs but was unable to. The dogs continued to harass the dog until they were able to leave the area.

Disposition:

I issued (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) a mandatory court appearance for the following violations:

36 CFR 1.5(g)(1): Engaging in activity subject to a permit without obtaining a permit.

36 CFR 1.5(g)(2): Violating a term or condition of a permit.

36 CFR 2.15(a)(2): Failure to restrain/ maintain control of pet.

On March 23rd, 2015, at approximately 1524, while on foot patrol on Stinson Beach, I observed an adult male and a female with a dog on Stinson Beach. Dogs are prohibited on the beach by way of signage at all major entrances to the beach. There is also a sign at the jurisdictional boundary on the north end of the beach informing all visitors on the Marin County beach of the closure to dogs on National Park Service land. The dog was not leashed and was actively chasing gulls. I observed the dog chase gulls three times.

Actions Taken:

I contacted the man and asked him to put his dog on a leash. He complied and leashed the dog. The man was also holding a large stick he was likely using to play fetch with his dog. I asked for the stick and the man handed it to me. I then identified him as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)) by his California Driver License.

Disposition:

I explained to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) I had witnessed three separate violations. He had a dog in an area closed to dogs, his dog was unleashed, and his dog was chasing and harassing wildlife. I also explained to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) that because he was compliant I was only going to issue him a citation for having the dog in a closed area and would give him verbal warnings for having an unleashed dog and allowing his dog to harass wildlife.

I issued (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) a citation for 36 CFR 2.15(a)(1): possessing a dog in an area closed to dogs.
