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On August 7, 2014, at approximately 947 hrs, I was notified by Communications to call a reporting party for a incident at Navy Memorial. The complainant, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) [REDACTED], said while he was parking his vehicle in the lot for work, a german shepherd who was with a training company aggressively approached him and almost bit him. Narrative: On 10/06/14 at approximately 1336 hours, I was in full U.S. Park Police uniform, driving a fully marked U.S. Park Police patrol vehicle. I was driving on the service road next building T1056 when I was approached by a male subject (later identified as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) by verbal information) who stated that his dog had just collapsed on Rodeo Beach. I immediately drove to the beach parking to locate the dog with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). Upon my arrival on the beach, there were two individuals giving the dog water to drink, and pouring room temperature water on the dog.

The dog was a five year old Chocolate Lab, a retired military Special Service Dog. (Explosive Detection)

I asked them to bring the dog back to the road so I can bring my emergency first aid kit from my patrol vehicle to meet with them.

Once I had my K-9 emergency kit, we checked the dog body temperature and pulse, the dog's body temperature was 104.5 and pulse was approximately 160 which are indications of overheating.

To prevent the dog from further heat exhaustion and further problems from rising body temperatures, I advised others to keep pouring water on the dog to prevent temperature from reaching 105.

After several minutes of watering the dog's armpit, groin and bottom of the paws, the dog was able to stand up on his own, and started to drink water as well as shake off the water on his body. However, the dog still was panting very hard.

I instructed (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to contact his vet immediately and transport the dog to an emergency vet.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) put the dog in the vehicle and left the area without any further incident.

Narrative: On 8/14/14 at approximately 1009 hours I was dispatched to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) in regards to a dog bite incident. When I arrived on scene I met with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) who stated she was walking her dog, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), on the Ecology Trail when a female approached from the other direction. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) observed that the females golden retriever was off leash. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated the other dog began growling at her dog so she moved as far away from the dog as she could on the trail. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated as they passed the golden retriever the dog attack the rear leg of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) did not sustain any puncture wounds but had injured her rear leg and was unable to put any weight on it. The pitbull charged them broke his leash, attacked her light brown/white hound mix, causing a deep puncture wound on her dog's neck. After the attack (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said she was shaken up by the attack and immediately left the area with her dog. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that she did not exchange information with the owner of the pitbull and was later contacted by the pitbull's owner through email.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that she didn't know her dog was injured at first but then noticed that her dog was bleeding.
