Narrative: On January 3, at approximately 1500 hours, I received a call from (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) regarding an animal complaint at Fort Funston. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) is a retired latent print examiner from (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) Crime Scene Investigations Unit (CSI). She had gotten my phone number from the secretary at CSI. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) had assisted me with latent print examinations for crimes occurring in the Golden Gate National Recreation Area (GGNRA).

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told me that she was walking with her dogs in the Fort Funston parking lot on Thursday afternoon, January 2, between 1630 and 1700 hours. Both of her dogs were unleashed. As she walked towards her vehicle, a short, stocky Hispanic male approached her with something in his left hand. She thought it might be food and began leashing her dogs. As she leashed one dog, she heard the man say in broken English, "Your angry dog came after me" and "She has rabies and I'll get infected." When questioned, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said that she did not hear her dog growl, bark, nor see the dog bite the man. The man claimed the dog put a hole in his pants above his knee, but when he rolled his pants up, there were no marks to be seen on his skin.

The dog's name was (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). She is a three year-old mixed breed Duck Tolling and Golden Retriever weighing approximately twenty-five pounds. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said that he dog had a prior incident of dog biting at a park in San Bruno.

The man called the Communications Section to make a report of a dog bite. While waiting for law enforcement to arrive, they exchanged contact information. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said that his name was (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) She said that he was driving a (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) van with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). She gave me his cellular phone number. She described him as being approximately 5'6", 170-180 lbs., with a brown beard and mustache. He was wearing a black-and-white bandana, white cargo pants, black shoes, gray t-shirt, and a long-sleeve green thermal shirt with a design of a white sword and wings with red print. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was worried that he was trying to scam her. They waited until almost 1900 hours before leaving Fort Funston. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said that her roommate, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), saw (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) thrust his knee towards the dog's mouth.

I recalled hearing a call over the radio the previous afternoon about an animal bite at Fort Funston. (Reference CFS 010214-61) Sergeant Scott Huther asked for assistance from the law enforcement rangers due to Park Police units being busy. Towards the end of my tour, I heard Officer Tera McBride go to Fort Funston, but she could not find the complainant nor victim.

I called (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). He told me that he had a scratch on his right knee, but he did not go to the doctor. I asked him to meet me at 1217 Ralston Avenue to complete a witness statement. Prior to my end-of-tour, I had not heard from him. The following morning at the beginning of my tour, I called Sergeant Larry Morales. I asked him if anyone had come in to report a dog bite during the first relief shift. He said that nobody reported any such complaint.

Narrative: On 01/07/14 at approximately 1320 hours, I was dispatched to 511 Simmonds Loop on the Presidio of San Francisco for a report of a (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was bit by an off leashed dog, the dog and the person with the dog was running away from the scene. Upon my arrival I saw the victim (later identified as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)) standing in front of the residence. I asked (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) for the direction of travel, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told me that it was a white female, blond hair, wearing pink clothing, with two large dogs (later identified as boxers), last seen running towards behind 511 Simmonds Loop, into the wooded area.

I approached the wooded area, I saw a white male walking several dogs, I asked if he has seen the female subject with two dogs, he replied "two boxers? I know they live on (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)". I then drove to the area of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to look for the subject.

ID Officer Whalen also responded to 511 Simmonds Loop for photograph of the injury and asked (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to give a written statement of the incident.

While in the area, I saw a white male sweeping inside of his garage, I contacted him (and identified him as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)) and asked him if he knows anyone on his block owns two boxers, and was walked by a female with blond hair, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told me "Yes, that would be my dogs".

Detective Polianos and Investigator Lopez responded to my scene and talked to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told us that the female with blond hair is their paid dog walker, she had returned the dogs to his wife (who was not home at the time), but we were able to locate and identified the dog walker as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) later confirmed by her (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) called (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) I talked to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) admitted that the dogs were involved in an incident; (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told me that she was at home at (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) so I responded to that location to meet with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C).

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told us that his dogs names were (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) the (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was the larger one (the one who bit (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)).

Prior to me arriving at the scene, I talked to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) over the phone, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) also told me that when he told (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) that her dog had bit him, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told him "you'll live" then continue to running away.

Prior to me arriving at the scene, I talked to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) over the phone, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) also told me that when he told (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) that her dog had bit him, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told him "you'll live" then continue to running away.

Once I met with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), I took a photo of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and sent it to Officer Whalen who was with victim at the time, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) positively identified (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) as the suspect who was responsible for the dogs who bit him.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told me "I know people (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) like that; they just want to pretend they are hurt and get other people in trouble. I didn't see blood when I was there". (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) also said "How do you know he didn't self-inflict the injury? He has all the tools? He wasn't bleeding when I was there".

A computer check of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) through USPP Communications for wants and warrants revealed that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was suspended with service needed. I gave (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) an opportunity to give a written statement regarding the incident, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told me "I better not so I won't incriminate myself, I am gonna talk to the dog owner first".

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told me that "I only let the dogs off leash when they are in the wooded area, the guy was just

trying to get hurt and get us in trouble. [REDACTED] also told me at first she left the scene because she had another dog to pick up, and then she later told me that she left because (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) had friends came up attempted to keep her from leaving the scene.

I issued [REDACTED] MVN # 4324003 for violation of 36CFR1002.15 (a) (2) – Failure to Restraint Pet and MVN # 4324004 for violation of 36CFR1002.34(a) (4) – Creating an hazardous Condition. I also issued (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) CA DMV Form #310 – Notice of Suspension.

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Narrative: On January 7, 2014, at approximately 1515 hours, I received a call from Communications about a woman who was in Sutro Heights Park and had been charged by a dog off leash with another woman. The complainant, later identified as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) had left the area but described the dog as a dark haired german shepard and woman walking it as a white female with a white jacket and black pants. I entered the park and saw a woman with a white jacket and black pants walking out toward Point Lobos. She had a dark haired german shepard type dog and a second lighter colored dog. Both dogs were on a leash. I asked the woman, identified as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) if she had one of her dogs off leash earlier and if she had encountered another visitor in the park. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) denied having either dog off leash and said she did not have any type of conflict with another woman in the park. I attempted to call the complainant at this time but left a voice mail. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said her dog did not charge anyone in the park and showed me a electronic collar she uses as well. I warned (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) about the leash law and advised her to use one of the many dog parks in the city. A few minutes later the complainant called back and said the dog was unleashed and ran up to her and her smaller dog aggressively. She had to back away from the dog and told (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) Sutro Heights was for dogs on leash.

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Narrative: On 04/06/2014, at approximately 1757 hours, myself and Ofc. S. Smith responded to the south end of Baker Beach following a complaint of a dog attack at that location.

I met with complainant (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) who stated that a large grey pitbull had attacked her dog, named (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), who is a black mixed shepherd weighing approximately 38 lbs.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said that her dog was limping but did not appear to have been bitten.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said that following the attack the suspect dog owner said that her dog was uninjured and "just whining." (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said the the suspect dog owner tried to leave and she stepped in front of him, held out her hand, and stated that she was "making a citizen's arrest and he needed to wait for police." (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said that the suspect dog owner said that "wasn't going to happen" and slapped her hand out of his way causing a small cut to her left index finger. The suspect then left along the Lobos Creek trail in the direction of Lincoln at 25th Avenue.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) described the suspect as a white male, 6 feet in height, medium build, with brown hair, and in his early thirties. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said he left the area with his dog on leash and pushing a dark colored mountain bike.

Myself and Ofc. S. Smith checked the area for the suspect with negative results.

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Narrative: On April 14, 2014, at approximately 1200 hours, I received a call from Communications about a woman who was walking her dog on Baker Beach and had another pet owner's dog jump up onto her dog. I called the complainant, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), who said she was on the beach when two small dogs off leash ran up and jumped onto her little dog, possibly biting him. She said two men were following the dogs and had no control over them. She asked them to leash their out of control pets and they said, "your not our fucking mother." She continued walking south while they continued north. I told her that I would try and contact the two men and hear their side of the story. I went down to north Baker Beach and found the two subjects lying on the beach with two small dogs. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said he did encounter a woman with a small dog but that his dog only drop kicked her dog and did not bite him. I advised (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to keep his dogs on leash if they can not be kept under voice control.

Narrative:

On 05/05/2014 at approximately 2010 hours, U.S. Park Police CommSec dispatched me to a complaint of a dog bite at Morton Field. Officer Michael and I responded to the area. Officer Michael located (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) on Morton Field walking back towards her residence of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) with her two dogs, approximately 70 to 80 pound gray Staffordshire Terrier mix breed dogs. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was holding one dog on leash while a friend who had shown up to the incident after the fact was holding a second dog on leash. Officer Michael advised that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) reported that her dogs and another dog had gotten into a fight and she had been bitten. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was walking quickly towards her residence when I observed (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and a juvenile neighbor access Rodriguez Street from Morton Field. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) right hand was bloody, and he told me that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) dogs had bit him. I told (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to stop and provide identification, at which time; I saw that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) had blood on her right hand as well. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that she would provide identification but she wanted to secure her dogs first.

I followed (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to the rear of her residence, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), and she invited me inside. She was very excitable, speaking and moving around quickly. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) wanted to secure her dogs, check on her injured hand, check the status of the other party's injured dog, and get her identification. She kept moving around in her kitchen but was not achieving any of the tasks. I finally told her poignantly to secure the dogs. Once she returned to the kitchen I had to tell her to get something to put on her hand to stop the bleeding. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) had refused medical; however, SFFD ENG51 was already in route. Once SFFD paramedics arrived on scene and were treating (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) I moved outside to speak with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C).

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was also receiving treatment from SFFD paramedics. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) advised me that the dog he was with belonged to his roommate who was already on her way to the Vet to seek medical attention for the dog. The dog (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was with is an approximate 17-pound tan female Cock-a-poo approximately 4-1/2 years old named (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) belonging to his roommate, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C).

Both (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) refused transport to a medical facility (AMA). I observed that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) had two puncture wounds to his right palm below the thumb, and two lacerations (one on either side) on the first knuckle of his right thumb. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) is right handed. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) had lacerations on her right hand: ring finger inside at third knuckle, middle finger left side at first knuckle, and index finger outside at first knuckle. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) is left handed. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that when the paramedic took her pulse rate it was 180 over 120. Sergeant Torche responded to the scene and provided a camera for photo images of the injuries.

I received the following statements of the incident:

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) - She is the owner of a female "Terrier mix" breed dog approximately 3-1/2 years old named (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) is a "service dog" for (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) late father. She is also fostering a male "Staffordshire Terrier mix with Dalmatian" breed dog approximately 9 months to 1 year old from the Oakland SPCA named (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). She has been fostering (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) for approximately 2 months.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that she was playing ball with her two dogs on Morton Field. Neither dog was on leash. She stated that she saw the little dog (Cock-a-poo named (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)) come onto the field. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) ran over to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and sniffed her, and then the little dog snapped at him, "not biting him". (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said that is when (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) forced (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) down and she ran over to stop him. She reported that she did not think that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was biting the little dog, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). She stated that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) grabbed both of her dogs and was holding on to them while she went to check on the condition of the little dog. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said that when she was checking (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) the little dog bit her hand. I asked her to clarify that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) had been holding Her dogs while she went over and checked on the little dog. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that was correct. She did not report any injury to either of her dogs.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) - He was getting ready to take (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) out for a walk. He had her leash in hand when he opened the rear door of their unit. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) ran outside and down the hill to Morton Field. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) chased after her, and upon approaching the flat of Morton Field, he heard a female voice yelling, "No. Oh, no no no no." He report that he thought (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was going to "pee" but there were two "pitbulls" off-leash in the field that were now running towards her. He stated that the Pit bulls' "owner was screaming but it was too late. Both dogs had (his) roommate's dog by both ears. (He) tried (his) best to release both dogs. (He) was bit in the right hand."

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that both of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) dogs had a bite hold on the Cock-a-poo's head. Both (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) had one of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) ears by the teeth. He straddled one of the Pit bulls while grapping the other one by the mouth. He reported that he has had Pit bulls in the past and believed that "if they're good dogs, they'll let go if they feel they're biting a human." (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) reported that he put his hand into the mouth of the dog he was not straddling in order to get its mouth open. He stated, "Both dogs clamped on my roommate's dog's face. Both (dogs) did not release the biting for 5 minutes." He reported that he did not

want to just pull the Pit Bulls off because he thought they would "rip off (b) (6), ears." He said that he did not know how he finally got (b) (6), free but she was "all of a sudden running away", free of the other dogs' bite. (b) (6), stated that while he was trying to get the Pit bulls off of (b) (6), (b) (6), (b) had her hands down by the Cock-a-poo "trying to protect her." (b) (6), "believe(s) (b) (6), (b) (7) own dog bit her."

*Juvenile witness, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) – He was inside his residence along (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) overlooking Morton Field when he "heard barking, screaming and cries for help. (He) went on the deck and saw (his) neighbor, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) with a dog (gray Pit bull) in between his legs and the lady, owner of dogs also along with (b) (6), trying to separate the dogs from the white poodle mix. (He) immediately ran out to the field and (b) (6), had both dogs (Pit bulls) in his hands by the collar."

I had (b) (6), and (b) (6), (b) fill out a USPP Witness Statement (see USPP Form 44-02). (b) (6), (b) was too upset and advised she would provide written USPP Witness Statement for the following day. (b) (6), (b) had dog vaccination information on her computer and advised she would forward the information via email. I viewed a record for (b) (6), (b) (7) showing that her Rabies vaccination is valid until 01/13/2016; vaccine # (b) (6), (b) (7) Brand: Zoetis; administered at VIP PetCare, 5813 Skylane Blvd., Windor CA 95492. (b) (6), received his Rabies vaccination tag # (b) (6), in 03/2014 from East Bay SPCA, (510) 569-0702, (925) 479-9670. (b) (6), (b) (7) printer was not operating and she stated she would provide the records with the Statement form.

I issued (b) (6), (b) MVN 4472079 for offense 36CFR1002.34(a)(4), creating a hazardous condition. By having her two dogs off-leash in a leash compliant area, and by not being able to call her dogs off from attacking another dog and subsequently biting a person, I find that (b) (6), unduly created a hazardous condition. (b) (6), (b) signed the citation in understanding of instruction as given.

At approximately 2210 hours, I responded to Pets Unlimited Veterinary Hospital and met with the Cock-a-poo (b) (6), owner, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and (b) (6), were still in the emergency care waiting room, though, J (b) had been seen by a Technician and had her head bandaged. (b) (6), showed me (b) (6), Rabies vaccination record from SF Pet Hospital, 1371 Fulton Street, San Francisco, (415) 931-8312, showing she received her Rabies vaccination (b) (6), (b) on 07/05/2013, valid until 07/04/2016. (b) (6), had photo images of (b) (6), prior to being bandaged. I observed that both of her ears were injured and there appeared to be a puncture wound behind her left ear. (b) (6), stated that she would email the vaccination records and provide follow up photo images after (b) (6), was treated.

Time cleared: 2255 hours.

I was advised later that morning that the Cock-a-poo (b) (6), was held overnight at Pets Unlimited. She requires surgery for a puncture and tear behind her left ear, and sutures for both ears. (b) (6), also has a puncture on the top of her head. (b) (6), provided an initial estimate for medical care from Pets Unlimited showing a cost range of \$1538.00 to \$2054.00.
