Tabling will include **education about best practices for dog walking in open space areas, particularly off leash areas. A COPY OF ANY HANDOUTS MUST BE PROVIDED TO, AND REVIEWED BY, NPS PRIOR TO EVENT.**

WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN: Event must comply with San Francisco Green Event Guidelines as listed at the following website: <http://www.nps.gov/goga/planyourvisit/upload/GGNRA-Green-Event-Guidelines.pdf>. Permittee must provide own recycling, compost and trash containers for participants, as well as separate debris boxes for each. Permittee may NOT use existing garbage cans on NPS or adjacent jurisdictions. All refuse must be removed immediately after event, NOT left in NPS trash cans. Permittee is advised to hire San Francisco Conservation Corps, Wastebusters or other event refuse management. Violation of these terms will result in permittee being billed for trash collection at \$90/hour.

PUBLIC & EMS ACCESS: Access for other park visitors & emergency vehicles must not be impeded: ensure that regular park visitors—including those with mobility impairments—have at least a 36" path. For events closing streets or roadways, a 12" emergency lane must be maintained for EMS access. This permit authorizes use of parklands and does not grant exclusive use of the area.

DRIVING ON TRAILS OR GRASS: not allowed

SIGNAGE: 70/30 Rule: In order to avoid the appearance of sponsorship, any and all signs--on tents or otherwise--must be comprised of at least 70% information and at most 30% corporate sponsorship. If you have questions, check with NPS well in advance. Signs must not be visible before the day of the event. Any signs not meeting not meeting this requirement will be removed. All signs must be removed immediately after event. Signage is the exclusive domain of the National Park Service: affixing signage to existing buildings, property, signs, poles, and plants or other objects. Free-standing signs may be placed along route prior to event, but must be approved by the National Park Service prior to posting. All event signs must be removed immediately after the event, or permittee will be billed at \$90/hour for removal.

TENTS AND EQUIPMENT: No branded tents unless they meet the 70/30 rule. All equipment (except toilets) will be placed at least 20 feet from trails, roadways and bike paths. **NO STAKING; tents will be weighed down with water barrels or cement blocks.** If you need to access park fire hydrants, arrange this at least one week in advance. You will be charged based on water usage and staff time.

AMPLIFIED SOUND: Speakers must face away from residences, businesses or sensitive habitat areas (e.g. Crissy Field marsh, snowy plover habitat). Per CFR sound cannot exceed 85db at any time as measured at 50 ft. from A-weighted scale. No amplified music is allowed between 9pm & 9am. 1002.12 CFR.

SALES/PROMOTIONS: Sales of any sort (food, merchandise, etc.) are not allowed without a Commercial Use Authorization. Promotions (giveaways) to the general public are not allowed. Contact permit writer for more information.

PARKING: All vehicles must be parked legally. Please tell your participants that any illegal parking – including red zones, blocking doorways, parking on the grass, parking in a business' lot, etc – is subject to citation and towing. Vehicle travel off pavement not permitted, NO EXCEPTIONS. Access for other park visitors must not be impeded.

Permit holder is responsible for reading their entire permit and making certain that all participants follow all permit and park regulations. This is only a summary.

CONDITIONS OF THIS PERMIT

1. The permittee is prohibited from giving false information; to do so will be considered a breach of conditions and be grounds for revocation: [36 CFR 2.32(a)(3)].
2. The permittee shall exercise this privilege subject to the supervision of the Superintendent or designee, and shall comply with all applicable Federal, State, county and municipal laws, ordinances, regulations, codes, and the terms and conditions of this permit. Failure to do so may result in the immediate suspension of the permitted activity or the termination of the permit.
3. If any provision of this permit shall be found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this permit shall not be affected and the other provisions of this permit shall be valid and be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law.
4. The permittee is responsible for making all necessary contacts and arrangements with other Federal, State, and local agencies to secure required inspections, permits, licenses, etc.
5. Failure to comply with any of the terms and conditions of this permit may result in the suspension or revocation of the permit. Permittee will reimburse NPS for cleanup or repair of damages required to be made by NPS staff or contractor in conjunction with a terminated permit.
6. This permit may be revoked at the discretion of the Superintendent upon 24 hours notice, or without notice if damage to resources or facilities occurs or is threatened, notwithstanding any other term or condition of the permit to the contrary.
7. This permit is made upon the express condition that the United States, its agents and employees shall be free from all liabilities and claims for damages and/or suits for or by reason of any injury, injuries, or death to any person or persons or property of any kind whatsoever, whether to the person or property of the Permittee, its agents or employees, or third parties, from any cause or causes whatsoever while in or upon said premises or any part thereof during the term of this permit or occasioned by any occupancy or use of said premises or any activity carried on by the Permittee in connection herewith, and the Permittee hereby covenants and agrees to indemnify, defend, save and hold harmless the United States, its agents, and employees from all liabilities, charges, expenses and costs on account of or by reason of any such injuries, deaths, liabilities, claims, suits or losses however occurring or damages growing out of the same.
8. Permittee agrees to carry general liability insurance against claims occasioned by the action or omissions of the permittee, its agents and employees in carrying out the activities and operations authorized by this permit. The policy shall be in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 and underwritten by a United States company naming the United States of America as **additionally insured**. The permittee agrees to provide the Superintendent with a Certificate of Insurance with the proper endorsements prior to the effective date of the permit.
9. Permittee agrees to deposit with the park a bond in the amount of \$ waived from an authorized bonding company or in the form of cash or cash equivalent, to guarantee that all financial obligations to the park will be met, including the restoration and rehabilitation of the permitted area.
10. Costs incurred by the park as a result of accepting and processing the application and managing and monitoring the permitted activity will be reimbursed by the permittee. Administrative costs and estimated costs for activities on site must be paid when the permit is approved. If any additional costs are incurred by the park, the permittee will be billed at the conclusion of the permit. Should the estimated costs paid exceed the actual costs incurred; the difference will be returned to the permittee.
11. The person named on the permit as in charge of the permitted activity on-site must have full authority to make any decisions about the activity and must remain on-site at all times. He/she shall be responsible for

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

I just wanted to pass along I thought the session yesterday went very well...This group seemed a bit more eager to participate and were more realistic about the situation. Kudos to Erika and Kim for another well planned and informative session, and to Shirwin for scheduling these.

I really think these sessions are the first step for increasing the safety of the personnel in the work areas where dogs (and citizens) are in such high volume.

During the Fort Funston trip, i saw several things the bear discussion within the park staff - lack of signage for the emergency cell number for dispatch, signage for the expected voice control for off leash pets, a huge number of dogs in the park and dog walkers with so many dogs they clearly could not maintain voice control or even physical control if the need arose...nothing new, but certainly ongoing issues that a) are violations and b) impact the quality of visitation to the area...

While on the beach we were informed of a crazy lady on a horse, but never saw her - another ongoing issue under the umbrella of mixed use...

The parking lot was mellow and the hang gliding area seemed pretty undisturbed...

It was good for me to get out and see things again first hand, thanks Kim...

Shirwin - if we are able to get that tabling thing by SPCA supported, perhaps LE could be there and hand out wallet cards to pet owners that could be carried by them...the card would contain pertinent information like 1) location information and 2) the emergency number for dispatch as well as other info that would fit...at least then visitors might carry the card and refer to it, or put the number in their cell phone for when it is needed...just a thought - C

As you may have heard, the San Francisco SPCA is working on putting together a class at Crissy Field in partnership with the GGNRA to promote responsible dog ownership and teach behaviors that will help keep dogs under control in off-leash areas. Shirwin Smith listed you as a contact for permit inquiries, and I was hoping

to get some basic information from you regarding permitting to help with our planning.

We are looking at holding the class over a period of 4 weeks, one hour per week on a weekend day. Given the overwhelming work load from preparation for, and now cleanup from, the GGB 75th event, our staff this week was pretty much unavailable to address other issues, but likely we should be able to delve into this next week.

Hi Helen, I spoke to the Crissy Ctr. Director, and looks like Saturdays in general will work, but she asked if we could propose dates. Then she'll check with her staff to see who would be available to work. Cost of covering staffing on days the Center would otherwise be closed ranges roughly from \$70 to \$120 depending who would cover and if OT is involved. As to fencing a class area, we likely could provide some of that orange, temporary fencing that can be put up for the class and then removed after each session. That can be worked out when you discuss the permit with George Durgerian.

I also looked over your class outline and suggested a few wording changes and a couple of additions - using Track Changes. Mainly that we use the term "voice control" instead of off-leash, to emphasize the requirement for control. I'm very sorry to be so slow in providing a constructive response. Our challenge is that this request lies between the business office (which usually handles recurring classes but never fences off parkland) and the Special Event Office (which deals with one-time-only events and fences off areas for, say, concerts or beer gardens), What I need is an application with a description of what you're looking to do, and we'll try to find a way to make it happen. As the bottom of my "signature," you'll find a link to Special Park Uses permits. Fill out the "special event" application and email or fax it to me so we can get the process started.

We'll probably end up waiving fees—as this project is obviously of benefit to both parties and may be the

beginning of some sort of partnership—but may charge a limited staffing charge to oversee one or two sessions. We're mandated by law to be a "cost-recovery" program so that taxpayers don't end up subsidizing private events, but we're also not allowed to profit from events, so we have to balance our charges carefully.

In the meantime, fill out the application and include as many details as you can, and we'll go from there.
