

Guidelines for Artist in Residence Program, Great Basin National Park

The deadline for submission is March 1, 2017. All applications should be sent to:

All application materials must be sent digitally on a CD or DVD disc.

All images should be saved in .jpeg format.

Please ensure all written material (including resume and statement) is saved in .doc or .pdf format.

All audio or visual files should be saved in .wav format.

All applications must include:

1. a personal statement
2. resume
3. three professional references
4. digital examples of artwork

All artistic mediums are accepted.

Personal Statement: Please explain your medium, why you are interested in Great Basin National Park and its Artist-in-Residence Program, and what you hope to achieve by your residency. Emphasis should be on what type of programs you plan to do. Please include this as a digital file on your application disc.

Resume: Along with your resume, please list three references. These references should be persons you have worked with, who know you, your work habits, and creative work. Please include this as a digital file on your application disc.

Examples of Artwork:

Visual Artists: Please send at least five (5) but no more than ten (10) examples of your work on a CD or DVD disc in a .jpeg format.

Authors/Poets: Please send no more than five (5) examples. Each example should be no longer than four (4) pages. Excerpts from longer pieces, with a general explanation of the original piece, will be accepted. All written pieces should be saved in .doc or .pdf format.

Music/Theater: Please send no more than three (3) examples, each no longer than fifteen (15) minutes in duration. Please send all visual/audio files in .wav format.

Your disc will not be returned.

Artwork of any medium in its original, physical form will not be accepted.

All submissions must be postmarked on or before March 1, 2017. Selection for the 2017 Artist in Residence will be made during the month of April.
