Snake Creek Canyon Closure and Stream Renovation

BAKER, NV – Great Basin National Park will be conducting a stream renovation treatment in Snake Creek on August 16th and 17th. The treatment will restore habitat for the native Bonneville cutthroat trout and fulfill the Park's obligation to the 2006 *Conservation Agreement and Conservation Strategy for Bonneville Cutthroat Trout in the State of Nevada*. Bonneville Cutthroat Trout will be restored to the stream within a year after the treatment. The project is being conducted in cooperation with the Nevada Division of Wildlife and the Bureau of Land Management.

To ensure the safety of Park visitors, Snake Creek Canyon will be closed from Monday August 15th until 3:00pm on Friday August 19th. Notices will be posted on all trails leading into Snake Creek Canyon.
