### Snake Creek Canyon Closure Extended 24 hours.

**BAKER, NV** – Great Basin National Park conducted a successful stream renovation treatment in Snake Creek on August 16th and 17th. The treatment restored habitat for the native Bonneville cutthroat trout and fulfilled the Park's obligation to the 2006 *Conservation Agreement and Conservation Strategy for Bonneville Cutthroat Trout in the State of Nevada*. Bonneville Cutthroat Trout will be restored to the stream within a year after the treatment. The project was conducted in cooperation with the Nevada Division of Wildlife and the Bureau of Land Management.

To ensure the safety of Park visitors, Snake Creek Canyon will be closed an additional 24 hours. The canyon will remain closed until 6pm, Saturday, August 20th.
