The following two teacher workshops will be offered this fall:

FOSSILS: ANCIENT LIFE REVEALED

OCTOBER 21 AND 22, 2016

Fossils are a fascinating way to connect students to our planet's distant past. They provide a unique peek into Earth's history, allowing us to see the abundance of life that has existed through deep time. Using Grand Canyon's diverse and colorful rock layers, participants will learn techniques for using fossils as powerful teaching tools in helping students grasp our planet's dynamic past, and how they help us understand the present.

GRAND CANYON ART THROUGH HISTORY

OCTOBER 28 AND 29, 2016

Delve into human creativity evident in the art fabricated by people interacting with the inspiring, challenging, and unique environment of Grand Canyon from ancient to modern times. Tour the behind-the-scenes museum collection, explore historic buildings, and interact with park artifacts in order to gather ideas for meeting state education history, art, and math standards with your students.

DETAILS

Participants arrive Friday evening for an introduction and keynote speaker address. The workshop resumes at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday and concludes by 4:30 p.m. that afternoon.

A \$50 registration fee covers workshop materials and guest speaker fees. Participants receive an entrance fee waiver. Generous private donations to Grand Canyon Association cover Friday night's lodging.

Enrollment is first-come first-served. Registration closes 30 days prior to the workshop.

Participants receive 9 continuing education credit hours.
