



Invite a ranger to visit your classroom

How would you like to have a ranger from Grand Canyon National Park visit your classroom? Through hands-on activities, the ranger will conduct curriculum-based programs free of charge geared toward your learning objectives.

We offer in-class programs for individual classes, limited to 35 students per 1 hour time slot. Program topics are:

- Geology
- Ecology
- Pioneer history
- Archeology
- National Parks (Ranger leads a “Build-a-National Park” activity in which students use art supplies to construct their own model of a national park. **This program requires 1½ hours.**)

We can also provide a one-hour-long school assembly program for up to 300 students. We have two offerings:

- “National Treasures in Your Backyard” – Focuses on the role and importance of National Parks.
- “Endangered Species” – An introduction to endangered species and what parks are doing to help them survive.
(The ranger will need 30-45 minutes to set up for an assembly.)
