



## TEACHING WITH ORAL HISTORY

### A TEACHER WORKSHOP AT GRAND CANYON

DECEMBER 2-4, 2011

Grand Canyon National Park is pleased to offer a special teacher workshop this December to help educators learn to use oral history as a teaching tool. This workshop will include information on incorporating oral history into your curriculum, interviewing skills and techniques, equipment and technology, hands on interviewing practice, guest speakers, tours of museum archives and historic park features, service learning project ideas, and teacher resources.

Participants will arrive at the park on Friday evening for a social gathering with park staff and oral historians. The workshop continues all day Saturday and finishes Sunday afternoon around 2:30.

Through a generous grant from the National Park Foundation, two nights of shared lodging are provided at no cost to you. We will match you up with another same-gender teacher for lodging purposes. In addition, the park entrance fee is waived for workshop participants. A \$50.00 registration fee merely covers workshop materials and/or other administrative costs of the event.
