Grand Canyon National Park Rangers Searching for Missing Man

Grand Canyon, Ariz. – Park rangers are searching for a man that left his residence in the Grand Canyon at approximately 2:00 a.m. on Friday morning, March 14, 2008 and hasn't been seen since then. When the man left, he was upset and it is believed that he took off on foot.

A search has been underway since late Friday evening when 29 year old Eric Stanley was reported missing. Eric is 6 feet tall and weighs approximately 180 pounds. He has short brownish blond hair, a goa-tee and mustache. He was reported as last seen wearing either blue jeans or kaki pants and a button-down dress shirt.

Flyers with information about Eric have been distributed throughout the community and information has been entered into both the Arizona and National law enforcement networks.
