

**Examples of park-specific projects include:**

**Apostle Islands  
National Lakeshore**

- Stabilize and restore the historic Raspberry Island Light Station Boathouse
- Endow the Lakeshore's 60-mile trail system
- Develop a "virtual tour" of Apostle Islands lighthouses



**Grand Portage  
National Monument**

- Reconstruct main historic bridge over Grand Portage Creek
- Endow mentorship program for Grand Portage Ojibwe youth
- Develop interactive computer for those not able to travel the Grand Portage
- Endow birch-bark canoe maker position



**Isle Royale  
National Park**

- Island educational trips for urban and disadvantaged students
- Stabilize the 1875 Menagerie Island Lighthouse
- Research declining coaster brook trout population



**Keweenaw National  
Historical Park**

- Print Junior Ranger project book
- Develop Copper Country "text book" for teachers
- Keweenaw heritage site sign program
- Construct first park entrance sign
- Develop trails & exhibits on Quincy Hill



**Pictured Rocks  
National Lakeshore**

- Preserve, restore and furnish the 1874 Au Sable Light Station
- Endow the Lakeshore's environmental education program
- Reconstruct popular hiking and ski trails
- Restore historic Coast Guard station landscapes
