Free Ranger Programs July 24 – July 30, 2016

Sunday, July 24

3:30 pm Afternoon Program – “Art for All Ages” -. Come sketch the dunes with a Ranger-artist and learn about the unique environment surrounding you! Free paper and chalk provided. Visitor Center, 30 minutes

9:00 pm Evening Program – “A Ranger’s Story” Come hear about the adventures and experiences of one National Park Ranger from the Mississippi River to the Medano. Weather permitting. Flashlights and jackets suggested. Amphitheater, 45 minutes

Monday, July 25

3:30 pm Afternoon Program – “Better Home Sand Gardens” -. Come explore the dunes on a Ranger hike and learn about the extreme plants and animals which share such a unique environment. Dunes Lot, 30 minutes

Tuesday, June 26

1:00 pm Discovery Activity - Find your inner Junior Park Ranger on this short hike to find out about the different habitats which make the Great Sand Dunes unique. You will collect soil samples and identify plants to find out what habitat you are visiting. This program is geared for kids 5 to 13 and will help them finish their Junior Ranger books. 1:00 pm Discovery Activity – "The Singing Sands" - The Great Sand Dunes are a symphony of geological and animal sounds! Discover how the Great Sand Dunes were formed while making the wild sounds found in the park. Fun for all ages! Visitor Center, 25 minutes

Friday, July 29
