Contest guidelines:

RESPOND TO THIS PROMPT: You live in one of the most wild places in the lower 48 states and this year marks the 50th anniversary of the Wilderness Act. Demonstrate YOUR DEFINITION of WILD & how/why wild places have importance for YOUR GENERATION.

- Be creative! Use documentary-style video clips, photos, humor, skits, music—the sky is the limit!
- UP to 4 STUDENTS can submit a video together, individual entries are fine too.
- Final video product must be 2 MINUTES OR LESS.
- Entries must be received on or before APRIL 15, 2014.
- All group members must be Teton County, WY high school students. At least one group member must be a SOPHOMORE (Class of 2016).
- The project must be STUDENT-DRIVEN. Some assistance from adults is ok, but no film professionals may be involved.
- All entries must have a LABEL OR TITLE SCREEN that includes all student(s) names, school, and the movie title. Please include contact information on the label or in your email.
- Be aware of COPYRIGHT Law: to use images/music, you must have permission from the creator. You could also search online for copyright-free images/music or use original images/music.
- Video content must not include or promote obscene, illegal, or unsafe behavior.
- Video should include English subtitles if another language is spoken on camera.
- Grand Teton NP has the right to display videos in any form of media including but not limited to websites and social media. Students name(s) and school(s) will be credited. FILM RELEASES will be requested from winners before prizes are distributed.
- WINNERS will be announced by the end of April as part of National Park Week, 2014. All PRIZES will include cash, park passes, and park-themed prize packs!
- TO ENTER: Mail a DVD to GTNP PO Box 170 Moose, WY 83012 — OR — post the video on YouTube and email the link to GRTE_Education@nps.gov. If the video is posted on YouTube, please make sure it is embeddable as the videos could be used on park websites. (To do this, check the “allow embedding” option under "Advanced Settings" on the YouTube video upload page.)
