2016 COMPENDIUM AMENDMENT: 36 CFR 1.7 Public Notice

AUTHORITY

Under the authority of 54 U.S.C. Section 100751(a), and Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations §1.5 (a) (1) the Superintendent is closing the following portion of the park to all public use. This closure is necessary for one or more of the following reasons: the maintenance of public health and safety, protection of environmental or scenic values, protection of natural or cultural resources, aid to scientific research, implementation of management responsibilities, equitable allocation and use of facilities, or the avoidance of conflict among visitor use activities.

Section 1.5 Closures and Public Use Limits

The following area is temporarily closed to public entry beginning October 9, 2016:

Specifically: The closure boundary begins at the junction of Highway 89 and Pacific Creek Road at UTM 538541, 4855810 (NAD83), and extends ½ mile to the West along the North side of Highway 89 to UTM 537898, 4856269. The boundary heads 550 yards to the East/Northeast to 538335, 4856418, and then follows the powerline to the East/Southeast for 650 yards where it meets the Pacific Creek Road at 538930, 4856243. The boundary continues along the Northwest edge of the Pacific Creek Road back to the Junction of Pacific Creek Road and Highway 89.

Closure signs are posted at the all of the waypoints listed in the above description and at pull-outs along the Pacific Creek Road and Highway 89 adjacent to the closure.

DETERMINATION

The National Park Service has established this closure as necessary to protect grizzly bears and other wildlife feeding on an elk carcass and for human safety.
