## Grand Teton National Park News Release

### Grand Teton National Park Co-Hosts Wellness Week Activities

Grand Teton National Park invites local residents and the visiting public to hike, bike or inline skate along a portion of the Teton Park Road on Saturday, October 14, in conjunction with the Jackson Hole Area Chamber of Commerce's health awareness initiative, called "Jackson Hole-Destination Wellness."

To facilitate only non-motorized recreation on part of the Teton Park Road, there will be a **temporary closure** for motor vehicle traffic from the Taggart- Bradley parking lot to North Jenny Lake junction between the hours of 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. During this time, motor vehicles will **only be** permitted to travel the Teton Park Road between Jackson Lake junction and North Jenny Lake junction; traffic will also be allowed to access the String Lake parking area by turning west from North Jenny Lake junction and returning via that same route.

Grand Teton National Park is also pleased to join The Murie Center in celebrating their annual Chocolate Moose Festival on Saturday, October 14, from 1 to 4 p.m. at the historic Murie Ranch in the park. Visitors are encouraged to burn some calories by hiking or biking along the Teton Park Road before indulging their sweet tooth on antioxidant-rich dark chocolates at The Murie Center's Chocolate Moose Festival.

Parking for the Chocolate Moose Festival will be available at the Moose Visitor Center lot. Participants are encouraged to walk the one-half mile lane to the Murie Ranch – another opportunity to earn those calories.
