



## Leigh, String & Jenny Lakes










# Hermitage Point, Two Ocean & Emma Matilda Lakes Trails





## Hiking Guidelines

- **BE BEAR AWARE!** Avoid surprising bears by making noise—call out and clap your hands at regular intervals. Do not leave food or backpacks unattended at any time.
- **Respect wildlife.** Do not approach or feed animals. Observe and photograph from a safe distance. Stay at least 300 feet from large animals.
- **Pets, bicycles and vehicles are NOT allowed on trails or in the backcountry.**
- **Hike on established trails to prevent erosion.**
- **Horses have the right-of-way.** Step off the trail and remain quiet while horses pass.
- **During July and August, trailhead parking areas may fill early in the day.** Begin early and carpool if possible to avoid problems. Parking on natural vegetation results in permanent damage to plants and may start a fire. Please obey posted parking regulations.
