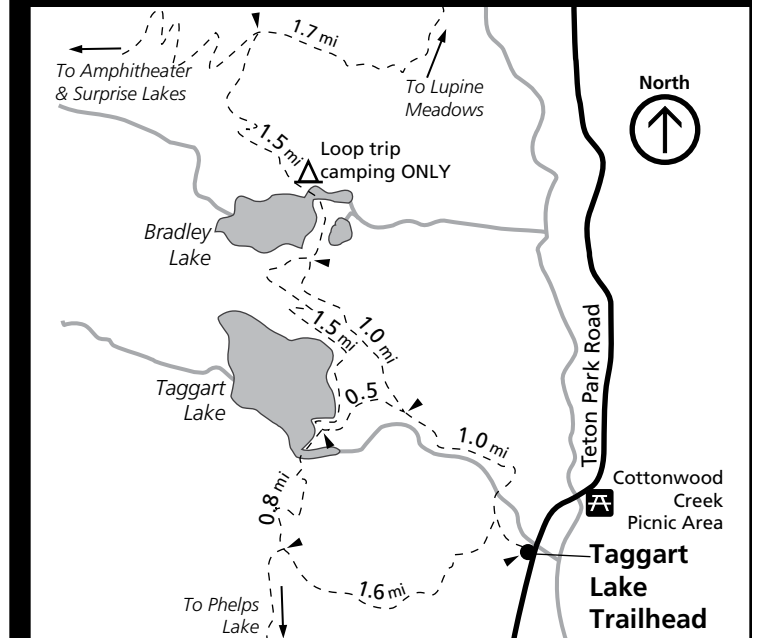

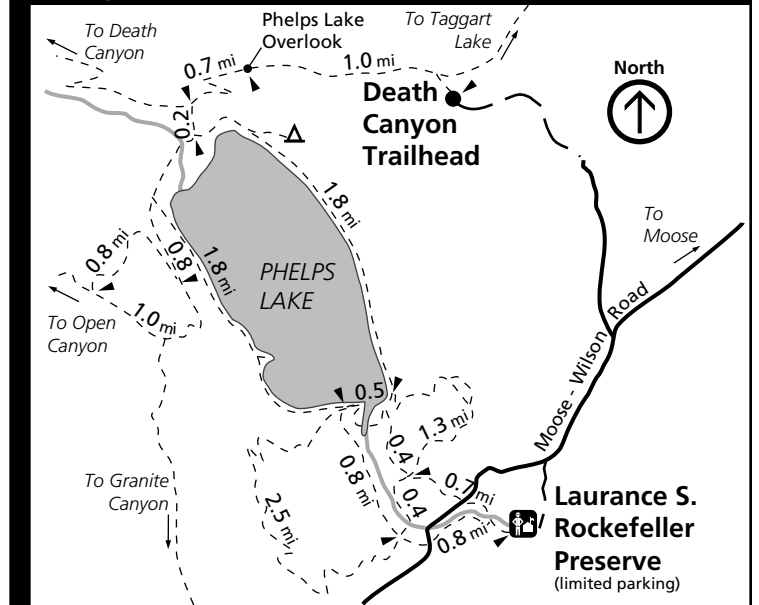
Hidden Falls/Inspiration Point



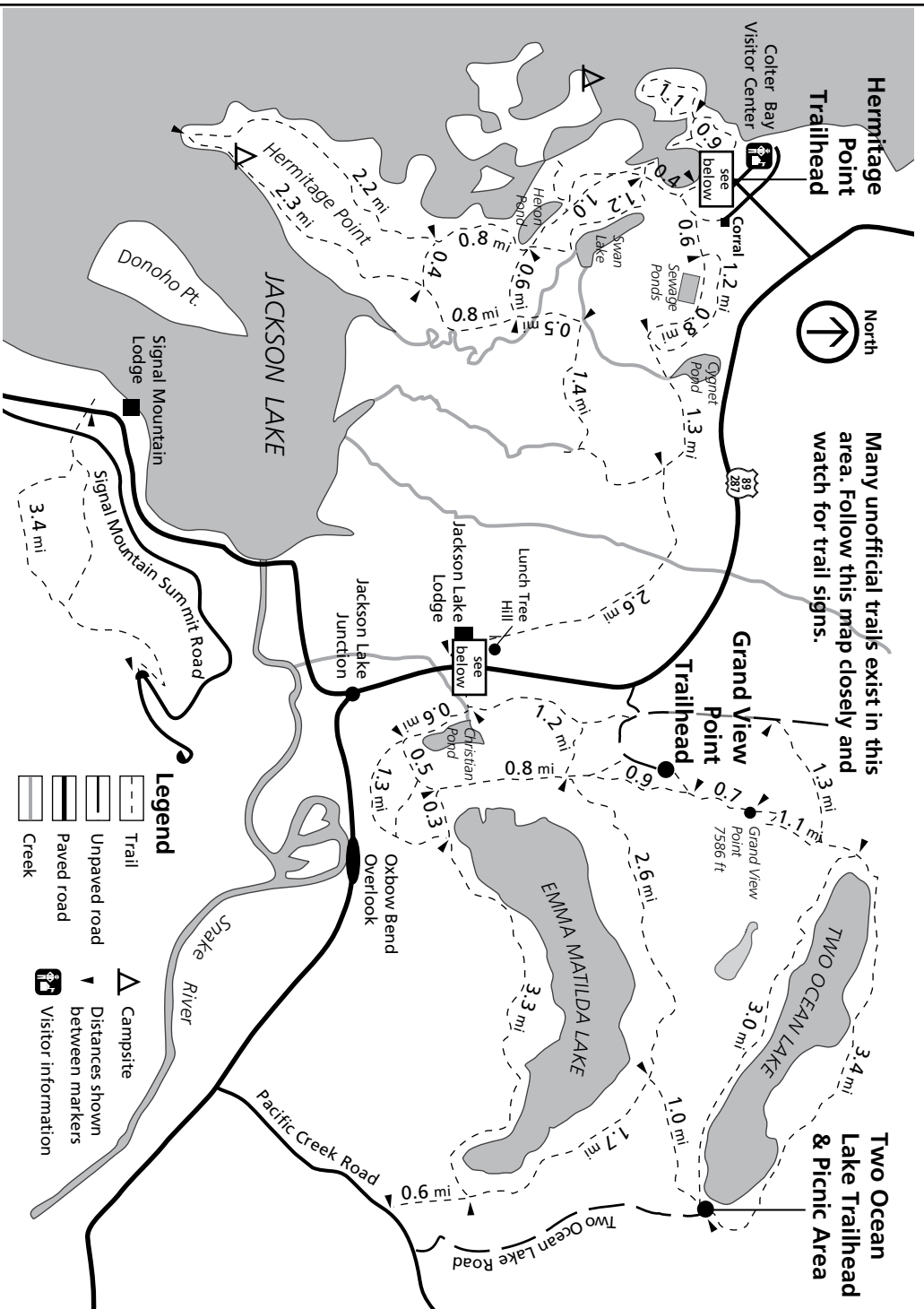
Bradley & Taggart Lakes



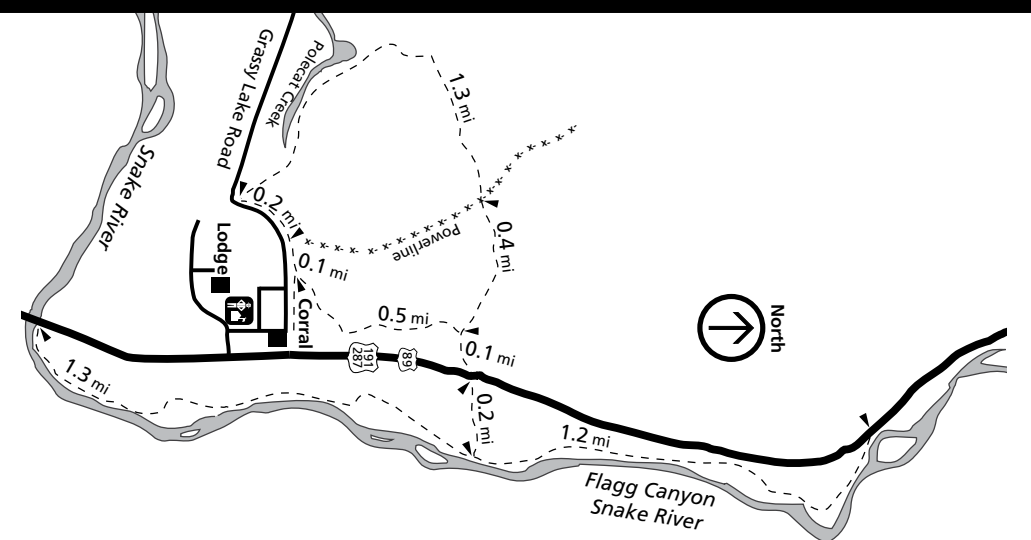

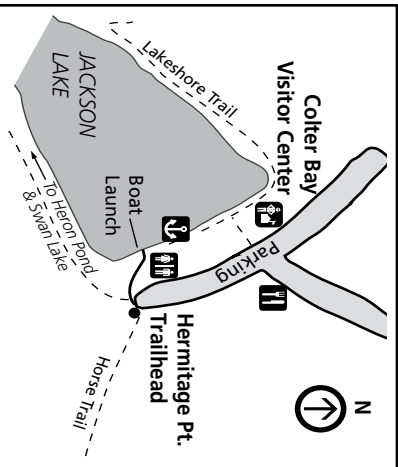
Hermitage Point, Two Ocean & Emma Matilda Lakes Trails



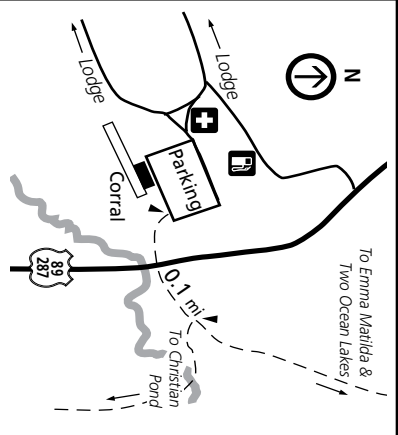
Flagg Ranch Area Trails

Hiking Guidelines

- **BE BEAR AWARE!** Avoid surprising bears by making noise—call out and clap your hands at regular intervals. Do not leave food or backpacks unattended at any time. Carry bear spray and know how to use it. Be sure not to spray it accidentally.
- **Respect wildlife.** Do not approach or feed animals. Observe and photograph from a safe distance. Stay at least 100 yards from wolves and bears, and 25 yards from all other wildlife.
- Pets, bicycles and vehicles are **NOT** allowed on trails or in the backcountry.
- Hike on established trails to prevent erosion.
- Horses have the right-of-way. Step off the trail and remain quiet while horses pass.
- During July and August, trailhead parking areas may fill early in the day. Begin early and carpool if possible to avoid problems. Parking on natural vegetation results in permanent damage to plants and may start a fire. Please obey posted parking regulations. GRT-01/2012
