


## UPPER PAINTBRUSH CAMPING ZONE



Welcome to the Upper Paintbrush Camping Zone. Unlike the other camping areas in the Cascade and Paintbrush drainages this is an open camping zone. The limits are: from .1 mile above the lower Holly Lake junction to one quarter mile below the Paintbrush Divide Headwall, on the main canyon trail. From the lower end of the zone to the upper Holly Lake Trail junction camp only on the south side of the trail (the left side of the trail as you hike up canyon). From the Upper Holly Lake junction to one quarter mile below the Paintbrush divide headwall camp on either side of the trail.

Camp at least 100 feet (200 is better) from trails and water. Use prior used sites rather than impacting new areas. Do not improve the sites by building rock windbreaks or ditching around tents. Fires are prohibited due to their extreme impact. Food and scented items must be stored in bear canisters. Use a shallow cat hole (4-6 inches) to defecate and carry out toilet paper.
