

Parent/Guardian Info Sheet for 2014 Summer Junior Rangers

*Our **number one goal** is for your child to have a fun, safe experience during Summer Junior Rangers at George Washington Carver National Monument. Parents can help and here are some tips:*

- Provide a signed Emergency Release & Photo Release before or on the date of the first session. Speak with the park ranger about special needs.
 - Volunteer to help with a session, if available.
 - Help your child be prepared for outdoor conditions:
 - apply sunscreen
 - wear shoes, not sandals
 - apply insect repellent, if desired
 - wear a hat or cap
 - bring a water bottle
 - bring rain gear, if desired
 - Ensure attendance at every session possible.
 - Drop students off at visitor center between 9:45 & 10:00 a.m. each morning, with a non-perishable sack lunch. We will provide snacks and water.
 - Know the daily pick-up location (visitor center) and arrive on time (2:00 p.m.).
 - Attend the Closing Ceremony on the Saturday, June 21 at 1:45 p.m.!
 - Sign up your Summer Junior Ranger for Carver Day, July 12th to work at the Junior Ranger booth & teach other kids how to earn a Junior Ranger badge.
