The Institute, hosted by the park and Harpers Ferry Historical Association, was designed to provide teachers grades 4 - 12 the opportunity to experience the important historical events and major players surrounding John Brown's famous raid. Throughout the week-long institute, Marjorie consistently contributed 9 - 13 hour days. She arranged set-up and break-down logistics, coordinated lunches and dinners, and made sure all participants had all necessary training materials.
