Since his arrival, he has worked diligently on projects that are essential to the Park’s museum management program including developing a rare book preservation plan and then re-housing 430 rare books that came from the Storer College Library. When the threat of a Lowertown flood was at our doorstep, Mac did not hesitate to volunteer his time to help curatorial staff move our most precious museum objects out of harm’s way. Presently, he is working on the consolidation and re-housing of objects in one of the Park’s museum collection storage areas. Mac’s enthusiasm and excellent work is much appreciated as he plays a vital role in the successful management of some of our park treasures.

Mac is completing an MA in Museum Studies from the Center for Advanced Study of Museum Science and Heritage Management at Texas Tech University. While in the program, he pursued his interest in collections management, and developed professional aspirations to become a collections manager or registrar. The Museum Science program provided Mac a solid foundation in museum practices and theories, as well as the development of collection care and management.

Before coming to Harpers Ferry, Mac worked in a wide variety of museums and galleries in both his home state of Texas and abroad - spending a year in London studying museum theory while interning at the Leighton House Museum. After graduation, Mac hopes to continue to pursue his interest in history through museum work within the National Park Services.
