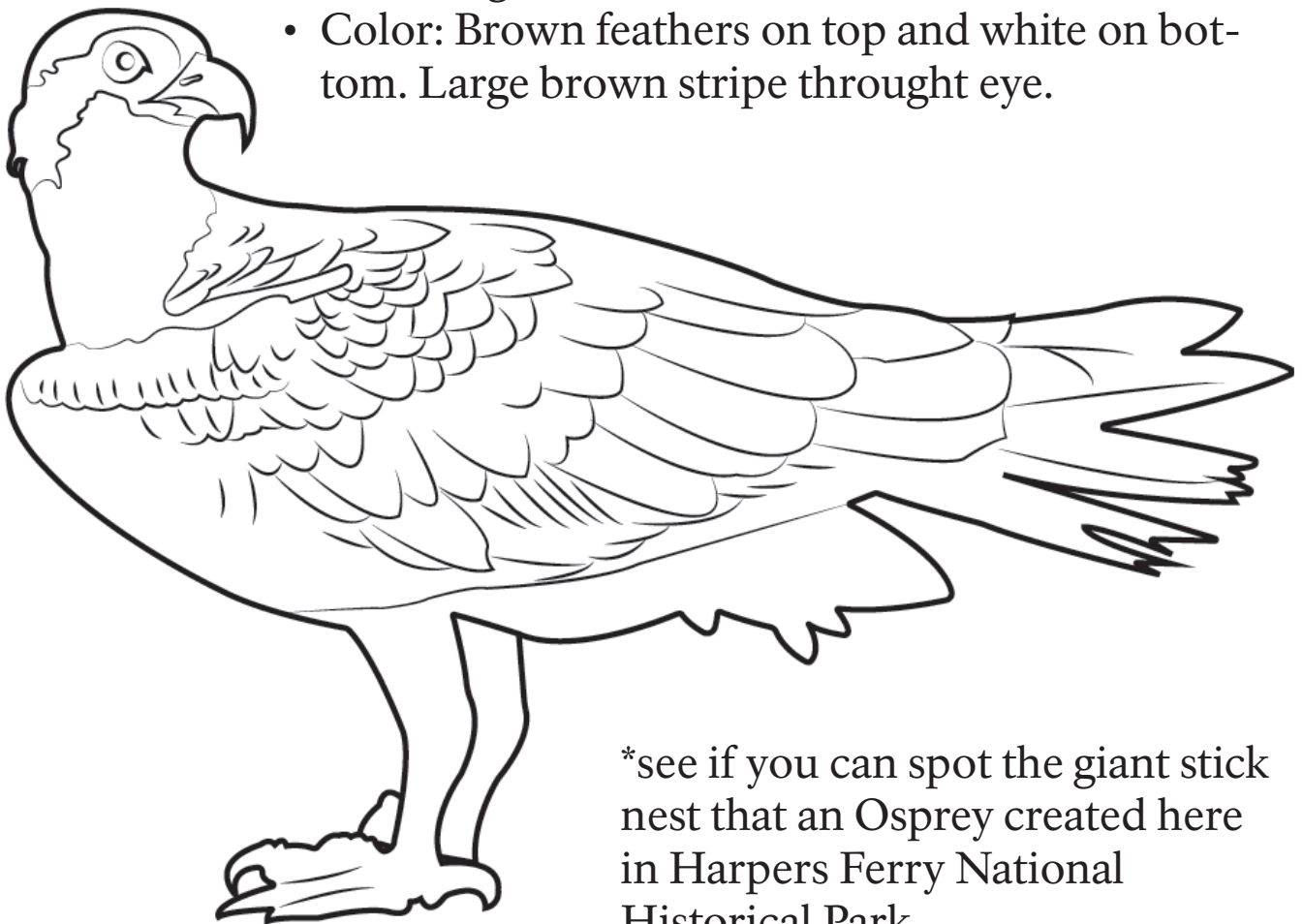


Osprey

(Pandion haliaetus)

- Ospreys can be found around nearly any body of water like rivers, saltmarshes, ponds, reservoirs, estuaries, and even coral reefs
- They love to eat live fish and are able to catch 1 fish in every 4 dives
- Ospreys are good at soaring and diving, but since they can't maneuver as well as other hawks, they stay in open areas to fly

- Size: Large
- Color: Brown feathers on top and white on bottom. Large brown stripe through eye.
