Restrooms for wheelchair access are located on the 2nd floor of John Brown Museum.


Wheelchairs are available in the Information Center and Visitor Center

Sidewalks in the park are generally accessible, but may be difficult in spots due to uneven surfaces and gaps in the flagstones.

Dry trail surfaces are generally suitable, but are usually difficult when wet. The trail to The Point is loose gravel.
