Thank you for your interest in Hamilton Grange National Memorial.

Inside of Saint Nicholas Park, in the Hamilton Heights section of Manhattan, you will find the Federalist-style home of one of the founders of the United States, Alexander Hamilton. Called "The Grange," this early-nineteenth-century home has survived to tell the story of a man who rose from very humble beginnings to become one of the most influential members of the Founding Generation of the United States.

Hours & Location:

Hamilton Grange National Memorial is located in Saint Nicholas Park at 414 141st Street at the intersection of Hamilton Terrace, between Saint Nicholas Avenue and Convent Avenue. Our days of operation are Wednesday through Sunday. We are closed Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas day. The ground floor exhibits are available from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. The first floor is accessible to the mobility impaired by a lift that can accommodate one person at a time. Please indicate on your request form, if your group will need to use the lift.

Admission:

Hamilton Grange National Memorial does not charge an admission fee. Ranger-lead tours and programs are free of charge.

Tour Requests:

Group tour reservations are not accepted by phone. For groups of 10 or more visitors, please make a request by completing the reservation request form below and e-mailing it through the link on our website, or faxing it to (646) 548-9366.

Group tours are only available Wednesday through Friday at 10:00 and 11:00.

Group tour reservations must be scheduled at least 2 weeks in advance.

Please note: Group tour requests, do not constitute a reservation. We will make every effort to accommodate your request, but cannot guarantee time availability or staff availability until we respond with a confirmation fax or e-mail.

Your visit to Hamilton Grange will last approximately one hour. Tours of the 1st floor will last approximately 30 min, and there is a 15-minute video to view, in conjunction with the downstairs exhibit. The period floor houses the historical furnishings, and has a capacity limit of fifteen visitors at any given time. We can accommodate groups of up to thirty (30) visitors, which will then be split into two groups for tours.

NOTE: If your group is late for a scheduled tour, your time will be reduced by the amount of time that your group arrives late.

Confirmation:

Confirmation is required and group leaders must bring a printed copy of the confirmation with them when they arrive at Hamilton Grange. Approximately one week after we receive your reservation form, a response will be sent to you via fax or email. Should you not receive a response within one week of the submission of your request, contact Hamilton Grange National Memorial at (646) 548-2310.

Please check our website “alert” section as your group’s confirmed trip date approaches, to insure that we will not be closed due to unforeseen weather or other circumstances.
