Shadow Wars

Spying In Revolutionary New York Saturday August 15 2015

Join the National Park Service on Saturday August 15th at Hamilton Grange National Memorial for a program on spies and espionage in the New York area during the American Revolution.

At 11:00 am a program on the Culper Spy Ring which operated on Long Island and provided General Washington with information on British plans to crush the Revolution.

At 12:15pm meet General George Washington as he discusses the value of intelligence during the American Revolution.

At 1:00pm meet a courier who carried messages between the lines to General Washington, and how he coded messages.

At 1:45pm a British Officer will discuss the Crown Forces use of spies and gathering intelligence against the American rebels.

Admission is free!
