Harlem Grown will demonstrate Caribbean cultural cuisine by offering a cooking demonstration with traditional ingredients.



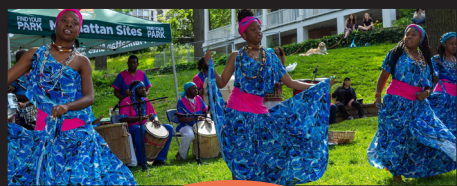
Hamilton En Español
