

CONDITIONS COVERING REPRODUCTION AND USE OF MUSEUM COLLECTION AND ARCHIVAL MATERIAL

All requests for permission to reproduce material for use and/or publication must be made in writing and include intended use, publisher, and expected publication date.

Permission is for non-exclusive, one-time use, one language, one edition, and covers only the specific occasion and use detailed on pages 1-2 of this request form. Permission is only valid for the individual, company, or institution to whom it is specifically issued and may not be transferred, assigned, sold, or otherwise disposed of without written permission of the National Park Service.

Immediately upon publication, one gratis copy in which the reproduction appears shall be sent to the National Park Service park granting the permission.

The full credit line shall be placed adjacent to each reproduction, or, in an illustration credit section or bibliography.

All negatives, transparencies, and loaned prints remain the property of the National Park Service.

Archival material must be reproduced unaltered and in its entirety unless approved in advance by the National Park Service.

This permission does not convey or confer copyright. NPS museum staff will assist as they able in ascertaining the copyright or restriction status of archival materials. In the case where restrictions or the copyright is held by a third party, written permission must be secured by the requestor from that party or their agent, and must accompany the requestor's application.

COPYRIGHT: The National Park Service can grant the permission requested only to the extent of its ownership of the rights relating to this request. Certain archival material and works of art, as well as photographs of those materials and works may be protected by copyright, trademark, restrictions, or related interests not owned by the NPS. The responsibility of ascertaining whether such rights exist, and for obtaining all other necessary permissions, remains with the requestor. The NPS makes no warranties or representations and assumes no responsibilities whatsoever for any claims against requestor or NPS by makers/artists, their agents, estates, or by parties in connection with the reproduction of material or works in NPS collections. The requestor agrees to indemnify NPS and hold it harmless against any and all such claims, including copyright infringement claims, royalty or fee demands and/or actions, including costs thereof, arising as a result of the requestor's reproduction of archival materials and works of art in NPS collections. Copyright ownership or reproduction rights may be retained by the maker or artist for material or works created after January 1, 1978. Any and all royalty payments or other requirements specified by the copyright owner of such material or works must be paid or honored by the publisher or agent requesting reproduction permission.
