Arkangel has just released his debut LP *Lito Arkangel...Me ke Aloha*, working with Grammy-award producer/musician Charles Michael Brotman (Palm Records). This LP features classic contemporary and traditional Hawaiian mele that not only reveals Lito's heart and soul but also perpetuates the true and authentic beauty of the Hawaiian culture. Lito was a finalist for "Most Promising Artist" at the recent 2015 Nā Hōkū Hanohano Music awards event.
