The modern Hawaiian 'ukulele evolved from the *Machete de Braga*, a small stringed instrument introduced to Hawai'i by Portuguese immigrants in the late 1800's. The 'ukulele has become an iconic part of Hawaiian musical culture and remains popular among locals and foreigners alike.

We will learn the basics of this beloved instrument.
