



- With thumbs and forefingers in the pockets, bring all the corners together.
- Find a friend and ask him or her to spell HOOVER as you manipulate the pocket squares back and forth until Hoover is spelled.
- Ask your friend to pick a letter that is on a flap.
- Open the flap and ask your friend the question under it.


