Panel discussions and break-out sessions will feature Latino scholars, community members, and leading preservation advocates.

The American Latino Scholars Expert Panel was established under the auspices of the National Park System Advisory Board. The expert panel provided advice on the conceptual frame and structure of *American Latinos and the Making of the United States: A Theme Study*, and advises the Board on engaging with the Latino American community to document their stories through the National Historic Landmarks and National Register of Historic Programs, and to enhance the interpretation and educational programs in national parks.
