1. NOT-TO-EXCEED RATES AND PRICES –IDIQ CONTRACT

B. **TRAVEL RATE**

All travel shall be priced in accordance with Section G, Number 5.

2. MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM AMOUNTS

- A. During the period specified in the “Ordering” clause, the contractor will be guaranteed a minimum workload of \$2,000 and the maximum workload limit will be \$100,000 during one year from the effective date of this contract.
- B. At the option of the government, this contract may be extended for an additional one-year term. If this option is exercised, the government will guarantee a minimum workload of \$2,000 in the second year. The total guaranteed minimum *cumulative* workload will be \$4,000 and the maximum *cumulative* workload will then become \$200,000 for the total two-year contract period.
- C. At the option of the government, this contract may be extended for an additional one-year term. If this option is exercised, the government will guarantee a minimum workload of \$2,000 in the third year. The total guaranteed minimum *cumulative* workload will be \$6,000 and the maximum *cumulative* workload will then become \$300,000 for the total three-year contract period.
- D. At the option of the government, this contract may be extended for an additional one-year term. If this option is exercised, the government will guarantee a minimum workload of \$2,000 in the fourth year. The total guaranteed minimum *cumulative* workload will be \$8,000 and the maximum *cumulative* workload will then become \$400,000 for the total four-year contract period.
- E. At the option of the government, this contract may be extended for an additional one-year term. If this option is exercised, the government will guarantee a minimum workload of \$2,000 in the fifth year. The total guaranteed minimum *cumulative* workload will be \$10,000 and the maximum *cumulative* workload will then become \$500,000 for the total five-year contract period.
- F. During the duration of the contract if the minimum workload is not met, in any year, the contractor agrees to carry over that amount to the following year.
- G. If a contractor declines to propose or declines work offered by the National Park Service at any time during the contract period, the estimated amount of the project will be subtracted against the minimum guaranteed workload limit in this contract.
