Independently, and not as an agent of the Government, the Contractor shall provide all services, including labor, materials, facilities, and miscellaneous services necessary to provide the U.S. Department of the Interior, National Park Service with new media maps.

2. **MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM AMOUNTS**

NEW MEDIA MAPPING SERVICES

- A. During the period specified in the “ordering” clause, the Contractor will be guaranteed a minimum workload of \$2,000 with a maximum workload limit of \$150,000 during one year from the effective date of this contract.
- B. At the option of the Government, this contract may be extended for an additional one-year term. If this option is exercised, the Government will guarantee a minimum workload of \$2,000 with a maximum workload limit of \$150,000 in the second year. The total guaranteed minimum cumulative workload will be \$4,000 and the maximum cumulative workload will then become \$300,000 for the two-year contract period.
- C. At the option of the Government, this contract may be extended for an additional one-year term. If this option is exercised, the Government will guarantee a minimum workload of \$2,000 with a maximum workload limit of \$150,000 in the third year. The total guaranteed minimum cumulative workload will be \$6,000 and the maximum cumulative workload will then become \$450,000 for the three-year contract period.
- D. At the option of the Government, this contract may be extended for an additional one-year term. If this option is exercised, the Government will guarantee a minimum workload of \$2,000 with a maximum workload limit of \$150,000 in the fourth year. The total guaranteed minimum cumulative workload will be \$8,000 and the maximum cumulative workload will then become \$600,000 for the four-year contract period.
- E. At the option of the Government, this contract may be extended for an additional one-year term. If this option is exercised, the Government will guarantee a fourth year minimum workload of \$2,000 with a maximum workload limit of \$150,000 in the fifth contract year. The total guaranteed minimum cumulative workload will be \$10,000 and the maximum cumulative workload will then become \$750,000 for the five-year contract period.
- F. During the duration of the contract, if the minimum workload is not met in any option year, the Contractor agrees to carry over the minimum amount to the following option year.
- G. If a Contractor declines work offered by the National Park Service at any time during the contract period, the estimated amount of the project will be subtracted against the minimum guaranteed workload limit in the contract.
