**I. SUPPLIES OR SERVICES AND PRICE/COSTS**

Independently, and not as an agent of the government, the contractor shall provide the National Park Service with all labor, materials, equipment, facilities, and travel, except as otherwise specified, necessary for the fabrication of visitor information signs (signs relating to pedestrian wayfinding, park regulations and safety, interpretation, resource protection and general information signs), wayside exhibit bases and hardware.

**A. FIXED-PRICES – INDEFINITE DELIVERY INDEFINITE QUANTITY CONTRACT**

**1) STANDARD PRODUCTS**

The following fixed prices shall apply for standard products produced under this contract and shall include shipping costs based on F.O. B. Destination.

B. **MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM AMOUNTS**  
(NPS 1489.216-140) (APR 1984)

1. During the period specified in the "Ordering" clause, the contractor shall be guaranteed a minimum workload of \$5,000 with a maximum workload limit of \$300,000 during one year from the effective date of this contract.
2. At the option of the government, this contract may be extended for an additional one year term. If this option is exercised, the government will guarantee a minimum workload of \$5,000 with a maximum workload of \$300,000 in the second year. The total guaranteed minimum cumulative workload will be \$10,000 and the maximum cumulative workload will then become \$600,000.
3. At the option of the government, this contract may be extended for an additional one year term. If this option is exercised, the government will guarantee a minimum workload of \$5,000 with a maximum workload of \$300,000 in the third year. The total guaranteed minimum cumulative workload will be \$15,000 and the maximum cumulative workload will then become \$900,000 for the total three year contract period.
4. At the option of the government, this contract may be extended for an additional one year term. If this option is exercised, the government will guarantee a minimum workload of \$5,000 with a maximum workload of \$300,000 in the third year. The total guaranteed minimum cumulative workload will be \$20,000 and the maximum cumulative workload will then become \$1,200,000 for the total four year contract period.
5. At the option of the government, this contract may be extended for an additional one year term. If this option is exercised, the government will guarantee a minimum workload of \$5,000 with a maximum workload of \$300,000 in the third year. The total guaranteed minimum cumulative workload will be \$25,000 and the maximum cumulative workload will then become \$1,500,000 for the total five year contract period.
6. If a contractor declines to propose or declines work offered by the National Park Service at any time during the contract period, the estimated amount of the project will be subtracted against the minimum guaranteed workload in this contract.
